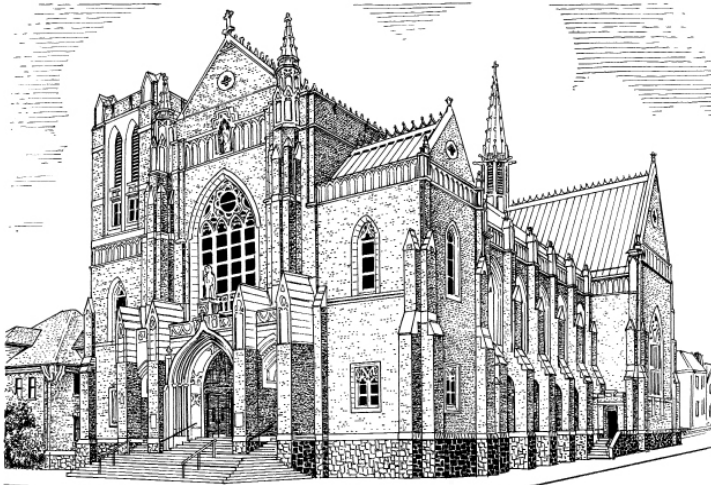

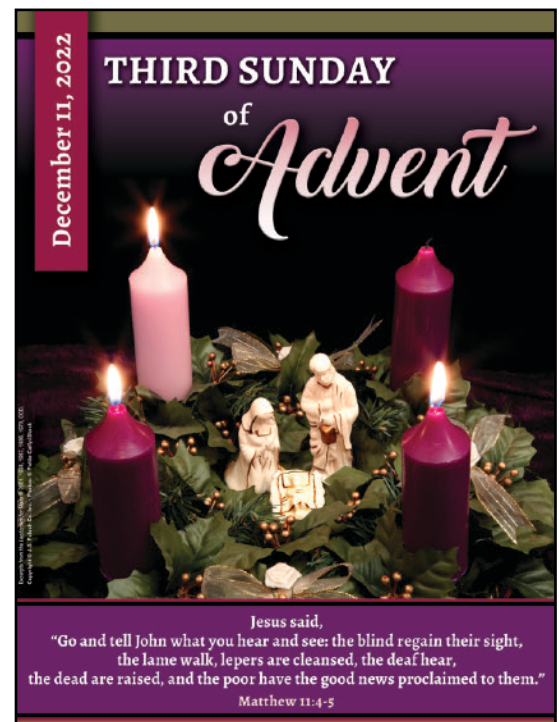

Be a witness to Jesus' Birth.

Last week, we heard John the Baptist inviting us to convert, repent, and prepare the way for the Lord. Today we hear Jesus praising John, who recognizes his role in His coming; he was preparing the people to be ready to receive Him. Faced with the question that John himself, through the disciples, asked Jesus, if it is Him, who is to come? Jesus does not respond directly; instead, Jesus answered them by saying, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind sees and the lame walk, the lepers are clean, and the deaf hear, the dead rise and the good news are announced to the poor; And blessed is he who finds no scandal in me!" He answered them by announcing all that he did as the Son of God, by His works, by His testimony. He answered that He is the one who is to come.

For this reason, this Third Sunday of Advent is known as the Sunday of the Testimony. Jesus himself, with His testimony, invites us to do the same: to bear witness to our faith, to bear witness of our being sons and daughters of God, and to bear witness to Christmas. We must continue in the process of vigilance that Jesus invited us in the first week and with the process of conversion that John invited us last week. But this week, we must be a testimony of Jesus. This Third Sunday of Advent requires us not to be afraid or ashamed to proclaim that we are Christians. We do not have to be scared to say that we believe in the Incarnation and the birth of Jesus. We must bear witness that Christmas is not only a vacation day as well as not a dinner. Christmas is not consumerism as the media are inviting us. Still, Christmas is saying YES to Jesus in our lives and families, and our testimony is the way for that communication and Announcement.

Brothers and Sisters, Christmas demands us to be witnesses of Love, Forgiveness, and Peace, testimonies of dialogue, reconciliation, and respect to be testimony of fraternal and friendly relations. Above all, this is in our family, our group of ministries, our Church, and our society. The world today asks for testimonies of faith, testimonies of the true Christmas, testimonies of the true Incarnation, and Jesus' actual Birth. Jesus, in today's Gospel, invites us to be His Testimonies. This Third Advent Week invites us to prepare a heart without fear, shame, and reservations about Jesus. We cannot let the noises of the world silence the voice of Jesus, the voice of God, and the action of the Holy Spirit. We cannot allow the world's cries to silence our being Christians Catholics. We cannot let the world and society confuse Christmas with presents, expenses, drunkenness, holidays, and sexual debauchery. My brothers and sisters, that are not Christmas; the actual Christmas is to be a Testimony of Jesus in this world that demands to be a Testimony of Love, a testimony of Peace, and a testimony of the joy of the Gospel.

Mary of Guadalupe is presented to us as that Testimony of bringing Jesus to our Hispanic people. Mary went down to a people that underwent a total transformation, with the birth of a new culture and a new people, and Mary came as a testimony of Jesus to help deliver these people. May she help us to be Testimonies of the child to be born?

May God bless us all.

Ser Testimonios del Nacimiento de Jesús

La semana pasada, escuchamos a Juan Bautista invitándonos a convertirnos, a arrepentirnos, a prepararle el camino al Señor. Hoy escuchamos a Jesús que alaba de Juan, que reconoce el rol que tuvo en su venida, preparándole un pueblo bien dispuesto a recibirle. Frente a la pregunta que Juan mismo a través de sus discípulos le hace a Jesús, si es Él, el que ha de venir. Jesús no les responde directamente, Jesús les respondió: «Vayan y digan a Juan lo que oyen y ven: los ciegos ven y los cojos andan, los leprosos quedan limpios y los sordos oyen, los muertos resucitan y se anuncia a los pobres la Buena Nueva; ¡y dichoso aquel que no halle escándalo en mí!» Les responde anunciándoles todo aquello que hace como Hijo de Dios, con sus obras, con su testimonio les responde que Él es el Mesías esperado que ha de venir.

Por esta razón este Tercer Domingo de Adviento es conocido como el domingo del Testimonio, ya que Jesús mismo con su testimonio nos invita a hacer lo mismo, es decir, a dar testimonio de nuestra fe, a dar testimonio de nuestro ser hijos e hijas de Dios, a dar testimonio de la Navidad. Tenemos que seguir en el proceso de vigilancia que Jesús nos invitó en la primera semana, y con el proceso de conversión que nos invitó Juan la semana pasada. Pero esta semana tenemos que ser testimonio de Jesús entre nosotros. Este Tercer Domingo de Adviento nos exige no tener miedo, ni vergüenza de decir que somos cristianos, no debemos tener miedo de decir que creemos en la Encarnación y en el nacimiento de Jesús. Tenemos que dar testimonio que la navidad no son las fiestas, las cenas, el consumismo a que nos están invitando los medios, sino que la Navidad es decirle SI a Jesús en nuestras vidas, en nuestras familias, y nuestro testimonio es esa vía de comunicación y de anuncio.

Hermanas y hermanos, la Navidad nos exige ser testimonios de Amor, de Perdón, de Paz. Ser testimonios de dialogo, de reconciliación, de ayuda, de respeto. Ser testimonios de relaciones fraternas y amistosas. Todo esto, ante todo en nuestra familia, en nuestro grupo de apostolado, en nuestra Iglesia y en nuestra sociedad. El mundo de hoy pide testimonios de fe, testimonios de la verdadera Navidad, de la verdadera Encarnación, del verdadero Nacimiento. Jesús en el evangelio de hoy nos invita a ser Testimonios de Él. Esta Tercer Semana de Adviento nos invita a prepararle un corazón sin miedo, sin vergüenza y sin reservas a Jesús. No podemos dejar que los ruidos del mundo acallen la voz de Jesús, la voz de Dios y la acción del Espíritu Santo. No podemos permitir que los gritos del mundo acallen nuestro ser Cristianos Católicos. No podemos dejar que el mundo y la sociedad confundan la navidad con compras, gastos, borracheras, vacaciones, libertinaje sexual, mis hermanas y mis hermanos, eso no es navidad, la verdadera Navidad es ser Testimonio de Jesús en este mundo que exige se hable de Amor, de Paz, de la alegría del Evangelio.

María de Guadalupe se nos presenta como ese Testimonio trayéndonos a Jesús a nuestro pueblo hispano. María se abajo a un pueblo que sufría una transformación total, con el nacimiento de una nueva cultura, de un pueblo y María viene como testimonio de Jesús, a ayudar a nacer a este pueblo. Que ella nos ayude a ser Testimonios del niño que está por nacer.

Que Dios nos bendiga.



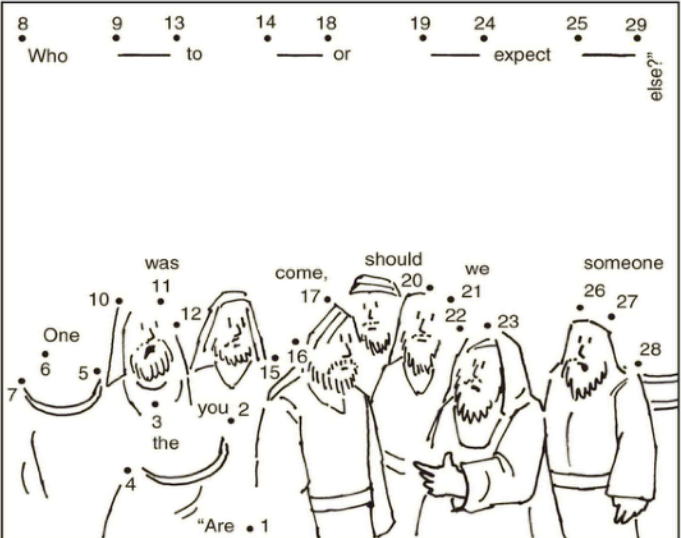
