



The Spirit of the Lord is upon me.

Last Sunday, we proclaimed the beginning of Jesus' mission from the Gospel of John. On this Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, we announce the opening of Jesus' mission from the Gospel of Luke. Luke the Evangelist, with his missionary spirit, puts the start of Jesus' mission in the synagogue of Nazareth, proclaiming the words of the prophet Isaiah, who said, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because He has anointed me for the anointing. He sent me to bring good news to the poor, to proclaim release to the captives, and recover sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."

In John's Gospel, Jesus started His mission with Mary, His mother. In Luke, we see that Jesus begins His mission with the Holy Spirit. Jesus proclaims, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me." Also, the Evangelists Mark and Matthew reveal the presence and action of the Holy Spirit because as He was emerging from the River Jordan during His baptism, the Holy Spirit came down upon Jesus as a dove. We see that the mission of Jesus, the task of living the kingdom of heaven, is accompanied by Jesus' consecration by the Holy Spirit. Thus, in each of His words, teachings, and miracles, the Holy Spirit is acting in Him.

Luke offers us five concrete actions of the mission of Jesus. These actions include all that Jesus did and said: His teachings, advice, warnings, miracles, the forgiveness of sins, the expulsion of demons, and all He proclaimed and lived. These actions are "Bringing good news to the poor." We know that the poor were Jesus' favorites. He was born poor; he identified with them, lived with them, and loved them.

Another action is "Proclaim release to the captives." Jesus' mission brought freedom to all those who were prisoners of sin. The same Jewish people under the rule of the Roman Empire accepted Jesus' true freedom. Another action was "giving sight to the blind." One of the great miracles we see in the gospel is when Jesus gives sight to the blind, especially the spiritual sight He gave to many people who believed in Him. He also brought freedom to the oppressed, especially by sin and evil spirits. And Jesus proclaimed that He brought about a year of grace. That year was when debts were forgiven, prisoners were freed, and spiritual graces were obtained.

My brothers and sisters, there is no doubt that the beginning of Jesus' preachings from the Gospel of Luke gives us great expectations in our experiences of faith. Jesus continues to proclaim the good news through every Catholic committed to their faith and parish and loves their religion and Church. Let us live all that Jesus offers us every day and announce the good news that He brought us.

May God bless us all.

El Espíritu del Señor esta sobre mí.

El domingo pasado proclamamos el inicio de la misión de Jesús, desde el evangelio de Juan. Hoy, en este tercer domingo del tiempo ordinario, proclamamos el inicio de la misión de Jesús, desde el evangelio de Lucas. El evangelista Lucas, con su espíritu misionero, pone el inicio de la misión de Jesús en la sinagoga de Nazaret, haciendo suyas las palabras del profeta Isaías que dijo, “El Espíritu del Señor está sobre mí, porque me ha consagrado por la unción. Él me envió a llevar la Buena Noticia a los pobres, a anunciar la liberación a los cautivos y la vista a los ciegos, a dar la libertad a los oprimidos y proclamar un año de gracia del Señor”.

Si en el evangelio de Juan, vimos que Jesús inicio su misión al lado de María, su madre. En Lucas vemos que Jesús inicia su misión al lado del Espíritu Santo. Ya que Jesús mismo proclama, “El Espíritu del Señor está sobre mí”. También los evangelistas Marcos y Mateo dejan ver la presencia y la acción del Espíritu Santo, ya que al salir del Río Jordán bautizado, se dejó ver el Espíritu Santo en forma de paloma. Vemos pues que la misión de Jesús, aquella de vivir el Reino de los cielos, está acompañada de la consagración de Jesús por el Espíritu Santo y así en cada una de sus palabras, de sus enseñanzas, de sus milagros el Espíritu Santo actuaba en El.

Lucas nos deja ver cinco acciones bien concretas de la misión de Jesús que podemos decir que estas acciones comprenden todo aquello que Jesús hizo y dijo, sus enseñanzas, sus consejos, sus llamadas de atención, sus milagros, el perdón de los pecados, la expulsión de los demonios, todo lo que proclamó y vivió. Estas acciones son: “Llevar la buena noticia a los pobres”. Sabemos que los pobres fueron los preferidos de Jesús, El nació pobre, se identificó con ellos y vivió con ellos y como ellos. Con su presencia y su preferencia por ellos, les anunció esa buena noticia, la cercanía de Dios, ser los preferidos de Dios.

Otra acción es “Anunciar la liberación a los cautivos”. La misión de Jesús trajo libertad a todos aquellos que estaban presos de su pecado, el mismo pueblo judío que estaba bajo el dominio del Imperio Romano, y aceptar a Jesús traía la verdadera libertad. Otra acción fue “dar la vista a los ciegos”. Uno de los grandes milagros que vemos en el evangelio es la vista a los ciegos, pero sobre todo la vista espiritual que le dio a gran cantidad de gente que creyó en El. También trajo libertad a los oprimidos, especialmente aquellos que estaban oprimidos por el pecado, por espíritus inmundos, por el mismo satanás. Y también Jesús proclamo que traía un año de gracia, es decir el año de gracia en el tiempo de Jesús, era un año en el que se perdonaban las deudas, se dejaba en libertad a los presos, se obtenían muchas gracias espirituales. Similar a los Años Santos que vivimos en nuestra Iglesia Católica.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, no hay duda de que el inicio de la predicación de Jesús desde el evangelio de Lucas nos ofrece grandes gracias para la vivencia de nuestra fe, Jesús sigue proclamando la buena noticia del reino por medio de cada cristiano católico comprometido con su fe, enamorado de su religión, de su iglesia, comprometido con su parroquia. Vivamos pues todo aquello que Jesús día a día nos ofrece y anunciamos la buena nueva que Él nos trajo.

Que Dios nos bendiga a todos.


