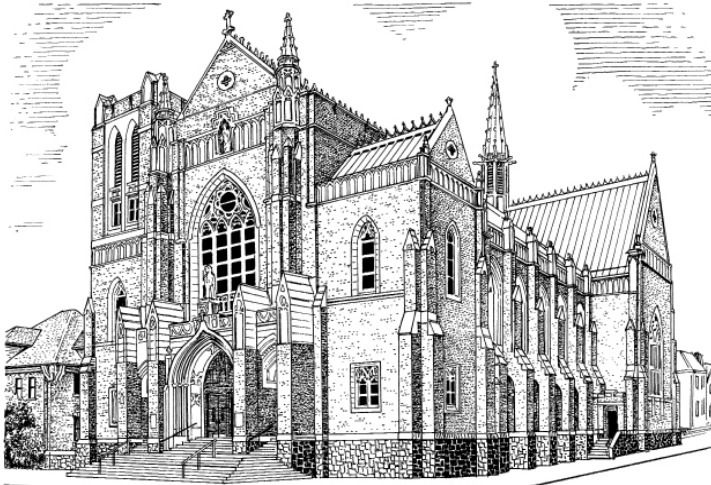

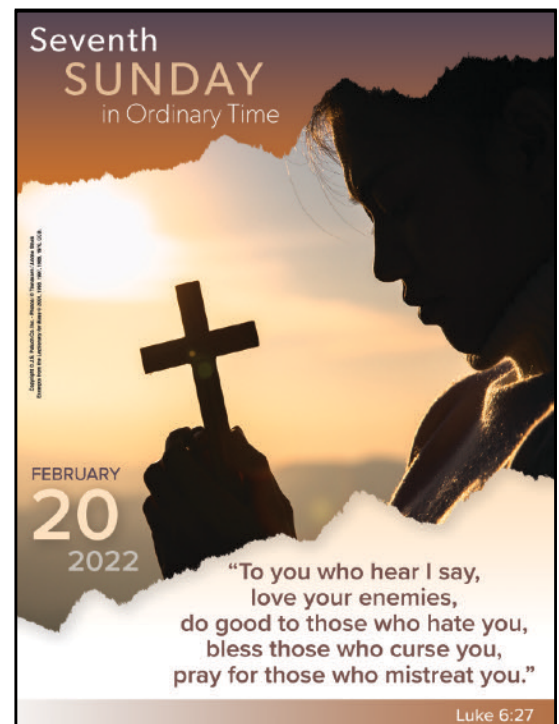

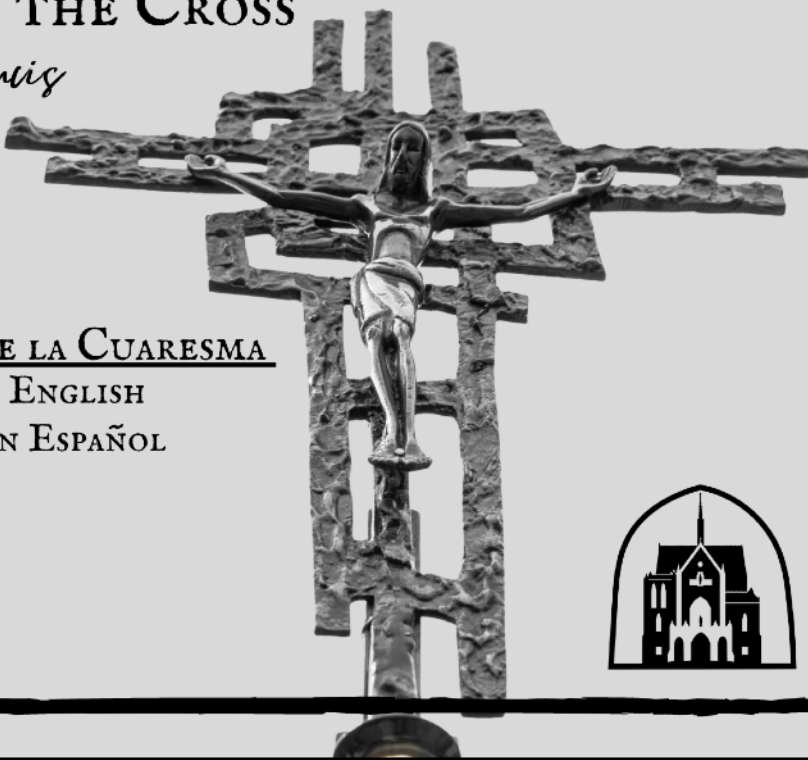

Pray for those who have wronged us.


In the Gospel of this Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus invites us to love our enemies, do good to those who hate us, bless those who curse us, and pray for those who slander us. Who among us can remain calm after receiving a slap in the face? At no time has Jesus said that His proposal is easy, but He did say that it would give us peace and the feeling that we are masters of ourselves when we do not allow ourselves to be provoked by social currents. The media offers us an individualistic, selfish lifestyle that invites us to look at ourselves and defend ourselves and not see others. Jesus' proposal invites us to look at others more than at ourselves.

Human and social logic tells us to do well and be grateful to those who do well to us. But on the contrary, do not do that with those who have wronged us. The logic of Jesus, the logic of God, is something completely different. Jesus asks us to love our enemies and pray for those who persecute us — something illogical to the human mind — as for the ideas that society poses to us. When we read about Jesus asking us to do this, we often see it as difficult and even impossible to follow. How can we love the one who has destroyed our life, who has destroyed our family? How can we pray for those who have wronged us? If we try responding from our purely human emotions, it will undoubtedly be difficult and, in many cases, impossible.

The question should be: Do I have Jesus in my heart? Is Jesus controlling my life? Do I live my human life with the experience of the Gospel? In this way only, will my brothers and sisters be able to love their enemies and pray for those who persecute and slander us? Only from the experience of God, the experience of Jesus, and the action of the Holy Spirit can the Gospel be lived. This attitude, the living of the Gospel, makes us children of God. Therefore, Jesus asks us to love, forgive, and share the Gospel and concretely give true meaning to the Jewish law. We know that all Hebrew laws can be summed up in the love of God and love of neighbor. That is the command that Jesus continually demands from us through the Gospel and the Last Supper. One of the expressions of love is forgiveness, which is expressed by loving enemies and praying for them. Not because of the damage they have caused us, but because they are a brother or a sister; they are in the image and likeness of God.

My brothers and sisters, no one has told us that it is easy to be children of God, to be Catholics, but we also know that it is not impossible. Everything depends on what relationship we have with Jesus, the Jesus of the Tabernacle, the Jesus of the Eucharist, Jesus of the Reconciliation, Jesus' presence in service, in the poor. Let's ask for the grace of God to help us pray for the people who have done us some harm. Only then will we be the children of God that Jesus promises us in today's Gospel.

May God bless us all.

Orar por aquellos que nos han hecho algún mal.


En el evangelio de este VII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, Jesús nos invita a amar a los enemigos, a hacer el bien a los que nos aborrecen, a bendecir a quienes nos maldigan y a orar por quienes nos difaman. ¿Quién de nosotros es capaz de quedarse tranquilo después de recibir una bofetada en la cara? En ningún momento Jesús ha dicho que sea fácil su propuesta, pero si dijo que nos produciría paz y la sensación de que somos dueños de nosotros y no nos dejamos provocar por las corrientes sociales. Los medios de comunicación nos proponen un estilo de vida individualista, egoísta donde nos invita a mirarnos y defendernos a nosotros mismos y no ver a los demás. La propuesta de Jesús nos invita a mirar a los demás más que a nosotros mismos.

La lógica humana y la lógica social nos dicen que hagamos el bien y seamos agradecidos con aquellos que nos hacen el bien, pero que por el contrario no lo hagamos con aquellos que nos han hecho algún mal. Pero la lógica de Jesús, la lógica de Dios es algo completamente distinto. Jesús nos pide que amemos a nuestros enemigos y que oremos por los que nos persiguen, algo ilógico para la mente humana, como para las ideas que la sociedad nos plantea. Cuando leemos que Jesús nos pide esto, la gran mayoría de veces lo vemos difícil y hasta imposible. ¿Cómo amar a aquel me ha destruido mi vida, mi familia? ¿Cómo orar por aquellos que nos han hecho algún mal? Si nos quedamos buscando como responder desde nuestra experiencia puramente humana, ciertamente nos será difícil y en muchos casos imposible. Creo que el cuestionamiento no tiene que ser como amar y perdonar a aquel que me ha hecho algún daño.

La pregunta que en realidad nos ayuda a dar respuesta a esta interrogante, no es como amar y orar por que nos han hecho algún mal, sino que la pregunta tendría que ser ¿Tengo a Jesús en mi corazón? ¿Jesús es el que controla mi vida? ¿Vivo mi vida humana desde la vivencia del evangelio? Solamente así mis hermanas y hermanos podremos amar a los enemigos y orar por aquellos que nos persiguen y calumnian, solamente así, desde El, desde Jesús y desde la acción del Espíritu Santo se puede vivir el evangelio. Es esa actitud, esa vivencia del evangelio lo que nos hace hijos de Dios, por ello Jesús nos pide amar, perdonar y compartir el evangelio y concretamente darle el verdadero al sentido a la ley. Sabemos nosotros que todas las leyes hebreas las podemos resumir en el mandato del amor a Dios y amor al prójimo. Ese mandato que Jesús continuamente nos exige en el evangelio y que nuevamente nos ofrece en la última cena. Una de las expresiones del amor, es el perdón, y este se expresa amando a los enemigos y orando por ellos. No por el daño que nos hayan causado, sino por su ser prójimo, es decir por ser imagen y semejanza de Dios. Pero repito esto solo es posible desde la experiencia y vivencia de la palabra Jesús.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, nadie nos ha dicho que sea fácil ser de Dios, ser de Jesús, pero también sabemos que no es imposible, todo depende que relación tengamos con Jesús, el Jesús de sagrario, el Jesús de la Eucaristía, el Jesús presencia en el servicio, en los pobres, pidamos la gracia de Dios para que nos ayude a orar por las personas que nos hecho algún mal, solo desde ahí seremos los hijos de Dios que nos promete Jesús en el evangelio de hoy.

Que Dios nos bendiga a todos.

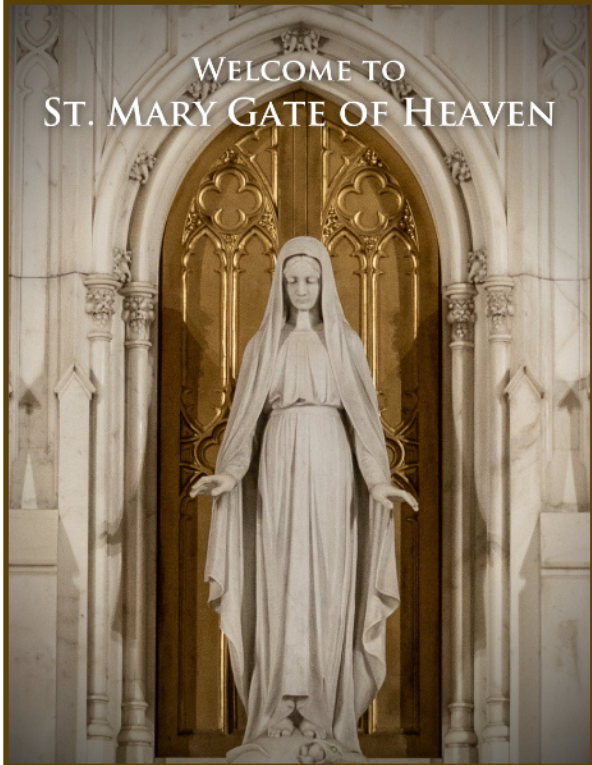
