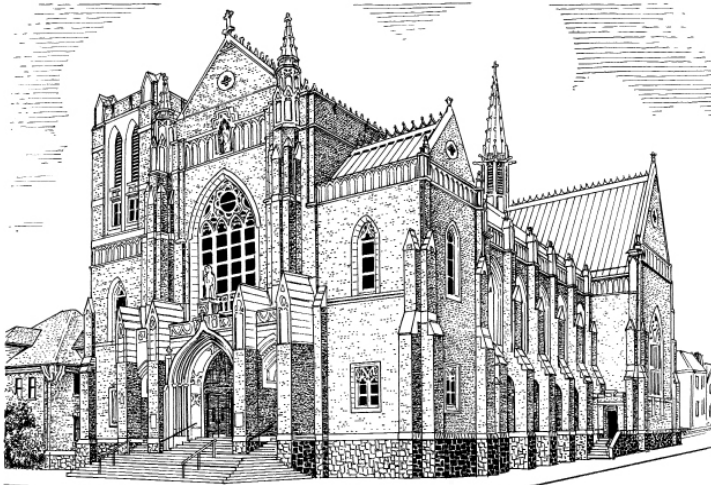

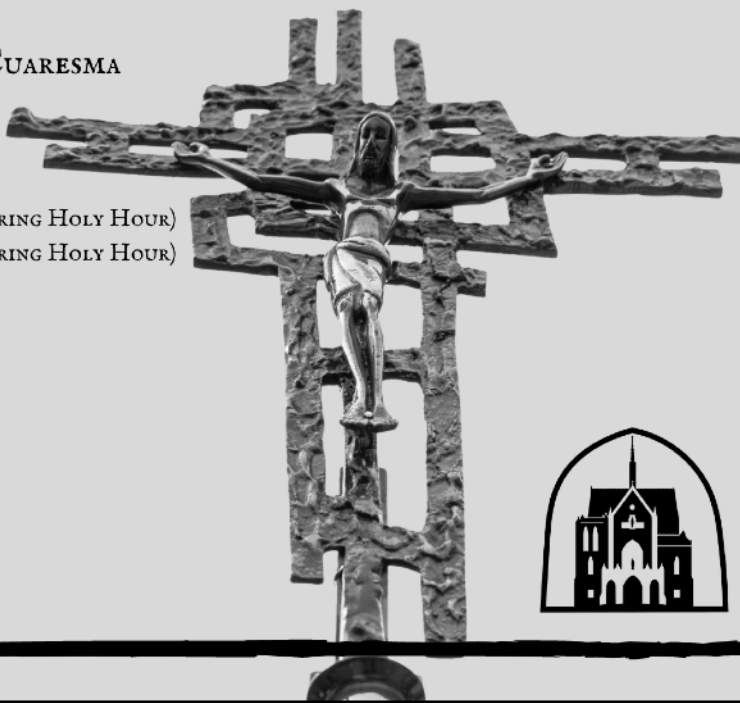

**Be good trees that produce good fruits.**

Dear brothers and sisters, in last week's Gospel, Jesus invited us to go further and deeper instead of staying in a normal or mediocre life. Jesus' demand is not only to love one another but to love our enemies and pray for those who slander us. In one way or another, Jesus invited us to look at the group of brothers and sisters who harm us, have done something negative to us, and express some evil desire. On this Eighth Sunday of Ordinary Time, Jesus is inviting us not to look at others. Still, today, Jesus invites us to look at ourselves and recognize that there is also evil within us and that we have also done some evil to others. But above all, He invites us to recognize it and repent. That is why Jesus tells us that a blind man cannot lead another blind man. Someone who has evil in their heart will only do evil until they repent and convert. If the danger is not averted, the two will fall into the hole of corruption. Jesus also invites us to reflect on times when we look at the evil of others, judge them, criticize them, and even condemn them. But we cannot look at ourselves and see the sin that we bring and commit. Many times, it is worse than what others may bring. Jesus invites us to look at ourselves before we look at others and criticize ourselves before criticizing others. Undoubtedly, this great teaching invites us to humility, the recognition of our mistakes, repentance, and the plea for forgiveness.

Jesus uses logical words in the preaching of His good news. He tells us that there is no good tree that produces bad fruits, nor bad tree that produces good fruits. Each tree is known for its fruits. The Gospel continually invites us to humility, simplicity, service, and to live Jesus' commandments in our personal lives. Each tree is known for its fruits. Whoever has Jesus in their heart and life will undoubtedly produce good fruits. Those who live a sacramental and graceful life will undoubtedly produce good fruits. And those who strive to live out Jesus' commandments will indeed produce many good fruits. Jesus continues to convey and proclaim this. It requires us to be good trees that bear good fruits because only in this way will they recognize that we are the children of God. This is the only way they will recognize us as followers of Jesus. Only then will they recognize us as members of our Catholic Church and members of Saint Mary Gate of Heaven Parish.

Brothers and sisters, what does Jesus require of us in the gospel? The Gospel invites us not to be blind but to perceive the needs of others, but above all, to perceive our personal needs. We must start a process of personal introspection, recognizing our faults, and continuing to walk in our life of faith. This is the only way we can relate to St. Paul: "For when I am weak, then am I strong." It requires us to continually look at ourselves and how the judgments or condemnations of others tempt us. It asks us first to judge ourselves, remove everything that does not let us see others well, and after that personal process, look and help others. It requires us to be good trees that produce good fruits because only in this way will they recognize that we are the children of God. Only in this way will they realize that we are the followers of Jesus because only then will they recognize that we are members of our Catholic Church and members of Saint Mary Gate of Heaven Parish.

**Ser arboles buenos que producen frutos buenos.**

Queridos hermanos y hermanas la semana pasada el evangelio de Jesús nos invitaba a ir más allá, a no quedarnos en la vida normal o mediocre, sino a ir más allá, y no exigía, no solo amamos los unos a los otros, sino amar a los nuestros enemigos, orar por quienes nos calumnian etc. etc. etc. De una u de otra forma nos invitaba Jesús a mirar a ese grupo de hermanos y hermanas que nos has hecho algún daño, algún mal. En este VIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario nos esta invitando no a ver a los demás, y mucho menos ver a aquellos nos han hecho algún mal, sino que hoy Jesús nos invita a mirarnos a nosotros mismos, y reconocer que dentro de nosotros también hay maldad, que nosotros también hemos hecho algún mal a los demás. Pero sobre todo nos invita a reconocerlo y a arrepentirnos. Por eso Jesús nos dice que un ciego no puede guiar a otro ciego, alguien que tiene maldad en su corazón solo hará sino solo maldades hasta que no se arrepienta y se convierta, si no se corre el peligro que los dos caigan en el hoyo es decir en la maldad.

También Jesús nos invita a reflexionar, esas veces que miramos el mal de los demás, los juzgamos, los criticamos y hasta los condenamos, pero no somos capaces de mirarnos a nosotros mismos y ver el mal que nosotros traemos y cometemos, muchas veces lo que nosotros traemos es peor que lo traen los demás. Jesús nos invita a mirarnos a nosotros mismos antes de mirar a los demás, de criticarnos a nosotros mismos antes de criticar a los demás. Sin duda que es una gran enseñanza que nos invita a la humildad, al reconocimiento de nuestros errores, al arrepentimiento y a la suplica del perdón. Jesús utiliza unas palabras muy lógicas en la predicación de su buena noticia, también nos dice que no hay árbol bueno que produzca frutos malos, no árbol malo que produzca frutos buenos. A cada árbol se le conoce por sus frutos. El evangelio continuamente nos esta invitado a la humildad, a la sencillez, al servicio a vivir los mandamientos de Jesús, es en la vivencia de esos mandamientos que se producen frutos buenos, toda acción buena es en sí misma un fruto bueno. Quien tiene a Jesús en su corazón y en su vida sin duda producirá frutos buenos, quien vive una vida sacramental y de gracia sin duda que producirá frutos buenos, quien lucha por hacer vida los mandamientos de Jesús seguro que producirá muchos frutos buenos, humanos y cristianos y así Jesús mismo se sigue comunicando y anunciando.

Hermanos y hermanas ¿que nos exige Jesús en el evangelio? Nos invita a no estar ciegos, y ser capaces de percibir las necesidades de los demás, pero sobre a percibir la nuestras personales, tenemos que iniciar un proceso de introspección personal, reconocer nuestras faltas y seguir caminando en nuestra vida de fe, solo así podremos expresar con San Pablo cuando soy débil, es que soy fuerte. Nos exige mirar continuamente a nosotros mismos, y si estamos tentados por juzgas, enjuiciar o condenar al prójimo, nos pide que primero nos enjuiciemos a nosotros, quitemos todo aquello que no nos deja ver bien a los demás, y después de ese proceso personal mirar y ayudar a los demás. Nos exige ser arboles buenos que producen frutos buenos, porque solo así reconocerán que somos los hijos e hijas de Dios, solo así nos reconocerán que somos los seguidores de Jesús, porque solo nos reconocerán que somos miembro de nuestra iglesia católica, miembros de nuestra Parroquia Santa María Puerta del Cielo.


