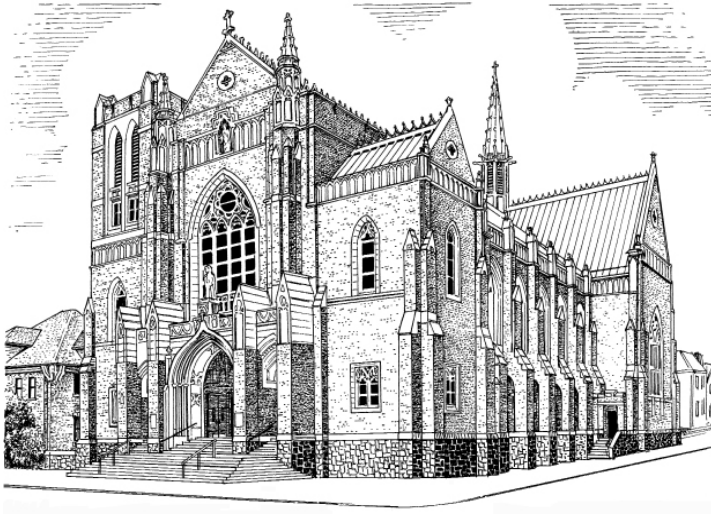

**Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.**

The Liturgy of Palm Sunday has two main critical parts. On the one hand, we remember Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, where He was received with songs, joyfulness, and gladness. On the other hand, the proclamation of the Passion invites us to reflect on Jesus' departure outside of Jerusalem, carrying the cross to where He was to be crucified for our sake. These two mysteries ask us to enter the fundamental mystery of our faith we will celebrate during the Easter Triduum.

On Holy Thursday, we remember the last Jewish dinner, the first Christian Mass celebrated by Jesus, in which Jesus instituted the Eucharist and, with it, the Priesthood. In addition to listening to the mandate of Jesus to love one another and live our faith experience from the service experiences, he gave us an example by washing the feet of his apostles.

Moreover, on Good Friday, we accompany Jesus in his condemnation, passion, and death. We proclaim the Passion, which invites us to enter the mystery of Jesus' death. He especially invites us to die with him, dying to our sin, dying to all that prevents us from living our faith, being children of God. As a result of this Good Friday celebration, we have the cross as a symbol that unites all Christians, and that is not only a sign of death but of life, of resurrection. On Holy Thursday, we celebrate the life Jesus gives us in the Eucharist, where Jesus comes as our food. We live the fundamental mystery of our life of faith, the offering of Jesus dying on the cross. Jesus invites us to love one another as he has loved us.

The resurrection of Jesus is the heart of our life of faith, so we not only remember that one day Jesus rose but, above all, we live Jesus' resurrection. And so, we enter on Saturday evening to celebrate and live the resurrection. This solemn vigil begins with the blessing of the new fire; Jesus is light and comes to enlighten us, comes to give us light and life, and becomes our guide illuminating our being. We walk towards the church, where we encounter the Word of God and where the Eucharist. We discover the life of grace through the sacraments that some of our brothers and sister will receive in Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation.

The Easter proclamation announces the resurrection and the life. The liturgy of the word beautifully takes us through the history of salvation with the proclaimed readings, seeing how God has become present throughout history. The blessing of the water and the sprinkling of the faithful invites us to renew the grace received in our baptism. The reception of the sacraments of our brothers fills us with joy. Nine brothers and sisters will receive the Sacraments of Christian Initiation in our parish, being cheerfully welcomed into our church: Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation.

My brothers and sisters, let us enter with Jesus into Jerusalem. But let us also go with Jesus to Calvary, and may we die with him. But especially with the mystery of life, passion, and death, let us enter the resurrected Jesus. May the experience of these mysteries renew our life of faith and help us be the presence of Jesus alive among our brothers and sisters day by day.

May God bless us all.

**Bendito el que viene en el nombre del Señor.**

La liturgia de la Palabra de este Domingo de Palmas tiene dos partes fundamentales. Por un lado, recordamos la entrada triunfal de Jesús a Jerusalén, donde fue recibido con cantos, alegría y regocijo. Y por otro lado la lectura de la Pasión nos invita a reflexionar en la salida de Jesús de Jerusalén cargando la cruz hacia donde sería crucificado por amor a nosotros. Dos misterios que nos invitan a entrar a si, en el misterio fundamental de nuestra fe y que vamos a celebrar en el triduo pascual.

Por un lado, el Jueves Santo hacemos memoria de la última cena judía, primera misa cristiana celebrada por Jesús, en la cual Jesús instituye la Eucaristía y con ella, el Sacerdocio. Además de escuchar el mandado de Jesús de amarnos los unos a los otros y de vivir nuestra experiencia de fe desde el servicio, ejemplo que El mismo nos dio al lavarles los pies a sus apóstoles.

Por otra parte, el viernes santo acompañamos a Jesús en su condenación, pasión y muerte, proclamaremos nuevamente la lectura de la Pasión, para entrar en ese misterio de muerte, sobre todo donde Él nos invita a morir con El, morir al pecado, morir a todo aquello que nos impide vivir nuestra fe, nuestro ser hijos e hijas de Dios. Como fruto de este viernes santo tenemos la cruz como símbolo que unifica a todos los cristianos y que no es solo signo de muerte, sino de vida, de resurrección.

Sea el celebrar la vida que Jesús nos ofrece en la Eucaristía y que también nos da con su muerte, entramos así a vivir el misterio fundamental de nuestra vida de fe, la Resurrección de Jesús. La resurrección de Jesús es el corazón de nuestra vida de fe. Nosotros no solo recordamos que un día Jesús resucitó, sino sobre todo vivimos su resurrección. Y así entramos la tarde del sábado a celebrar y vivir esa resurrección. Lo iniciamos con la bendición del fuego nuevo, Jesús que es luz, viene a iluminarnos, viene a darnos luz y vida, viene a ser nuestra guía iluminando nuestro ser, por ello Dios bendice el fuego nuevo y con El caminamos hacia la Iglesia donde nos encontramos con la Palabra, con la Eucaristía, con la vida de la gracia por los sacramentos que algunos de nuestros hermanos y hermanas vivirán, sea el bautismo, la eucaristía y la confirmación.

El pregón pascual nos anuncia la resurrección y la vida, se canta la alegría de la resurrección. La liturgia de la palabra hermosamente nos lleva a recorrer la historia de la salvación con las distintas lecturas que proclamamos, viendo como Dios se ha hecho presente a largo de la historia. La bendición del agua y la aspersión de esta nos invitan a renovar la gracia recibida en nuestro bautismo. La recepción de los sacramentos de nuestros hermanos nos llena de alegría. En nuestra parroquia nueve hermanos recibirán los sacramentos de la iniciación cristiana, el bautismo, la eucaristía y la confirmación, alegres le damos la bienvenida a nuestra Iglesia.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, entramos pues con Jesús a Jerusalén. Pero también con El salgamos hacia el calvario, y muramos con El. Pero sobre todo con El vivamos el misterio de la vida, resucitando con El. Que la vivencia de estos misterios renueve nuestra vida de fe, y nos ayuden a ser día a día, la presencia vida de Jesús en medio de nuestros hermanos y hermanas.

Que Dios nos bendiga a todos.
