



He must rise from the dead.

Dear brothers and sisters, we know that Jesus' resurrection is at the center of our life of faith. All the mysteries of Jesus Christ, the celebrations of the Virgin Mary, and the saints that we celebrate during the liturgical year have their roots in the Resurrection of Jesus. So, this Easter Sunday, we all rejoice and are invited not only to remember that one day when Jesus was resurrected but, above all, we are invited to live Jesus' Resurrection in our resurrection and our own life of faith.

Today, the Word of God tells us that after visiting the tomb and not finding Jesus' body, Mary Magdalene ran to tell the Apostles that Jesus was not in the grave. This is the first announcement of the Resurrection: Jesus' body is not in the grave. Jesus did not stay on the cross; He had risen as He frequently foretold when He was with His Apostles. When Mary Magdalene informs Peter and John that Jesus' body is not in the grave, they immediately go to see what had happened and also did not find the body of Jesus. The gospel tells us that John, the beloved disciple, entered the tomb and did not see the body of Jesus. He believed that Jesus had risen because until then, he had not understood the scriptures. My sisters and my brothers, we are invited to run and announce that Jesus is not in the tomb, that Jesus did not stay on the cross, and that Jesus has risen. We are invited to make that leap of faith and believe what Jesus is constantly telling us in the proclamation of His word.

Believing in Jesus' resurrection is not simply remembering the one day when Jesus was resurrected, but it is striving to live His Resurrection. We live Jesus' Resurrection when we live the fruits that Jesus gives us in His Resurrection. During this first week of Easter, we will hear about those gifts and fruits that Jesus offers us in His Resurrection. We will hear about the peace that Jesus offers us, every moment that He appears after He is resurrected, and He greets us by saying, "Peace be with you." We proclaim the joy that the women and the apostles felt when they recognized Jesus as they saw Him resurrected. We will hear about Him giving us the gift of faith, which He offers to us when he invites Thomas to believe and not be incredulous. He provides us with the gift of understanding when He explains the scriptures to the pilgrims of Emmaus, and they recognize Him in the breaking of the bread. Through the experience of these fruits of resurrection, peace, joy, faith, and understanding, we can assess how we are living the Jesus' Resurrection in our resurrection.

All those words and experiences that we will proclaim this first week of Easter are invitations to believe in Jesus' Resurrection. Faith is food for the soul. Believing in Jesus helps us be strong in times of doubt, little faith, and in times of tribulations and difficulties. So, like John in today's Gospel, let us realize that the tomb is empty, that Jesus has risen from the dead. Let us run to proclaim Jesus' Resurrection with our resurrection.

May God bless us all.

Él debía resucitar de entre los muertos.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, sabemos que la Resurrección de Jesús es el centro de nuestra vida de fe. Todos los misterios de Jesucristo, de la Virgen María y de los santos que vivimos a lo largo del Año Litúrgico, tienen su razón de ser desde la misma Resurrección de Jesús. Por eso este Domingo de Resurrección todos nos alegramos y somos invitados, no solo a recordar que un día Jesús resucitó, sino, sobre todo, somos invitados a vivir la Resurrección de Jesús, en nuestra propia resurrección, en nuestra propia vida de fe.

Es por ello por lo que la palabra de Dios hoy nos anuncia que María Magdalena, después de visitar el sepulcro y no encontrar el cuerpo de Jesús, corrió a comunicar que no estaba en la tumba. Este es el primer anuncio de la resurrección, el cuerpo de Jesús no está en el sepulcro. Jesús no se quedó en la cruz. Esto nos indica que Él ha resucitado como Él mismo lo anuncio en diversos momentos cuando estaba con sus apóstoles. Cuando María Magdalena les comunica a Pedro y a Juan que el cuerpo de Jesús no está en el sepulcro ellos también fueron a ver qué había pasado, y tampoco encontraron el cuerpo de Jesús. Nos dice el evangelio que Juan, el discípulo amado, al entrar y no ver al cuerpo de Jesús, creyó, porque hasta entonces no había comprendido las escrituras. Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, también nosotros somos invitados a correr y anunciar que Jesús no está en el sepulcro, que Jesús no se quedó en la cruz, que Jesús ha resucitado, y también nosotros somos invitados a hacer ese acto de fe y creer, creer lo que Jesús continuamente nos está diciendo en la proclamación de su palabra.

El creer en la resurrección de Jesús no es solamente recordar que un día resucitó, sino creer es vivir su resurrección. Y vivimos la resurrección de Jesús, cuando vivimos los frutos que Jesús mismo nos da con su resurrección, durante esta semana de pascua estaremos escuchando esos dones y frutos. Escucharemos la paz que Jesús nos ofrece, cuando en cada momento que se aparece resucitado saludará así, "la paz este con ustedes". Se nos proclamará la alegría que las mujeres y los apóstoles sentirán al reconocerle y verle resucitado. Escucharemos que nos dará el don de la fe, cuando invitará a Tomás a creer y no ser incrédulo. Nos ofrece el don del entendimiento, cuando les explicará las escrituras a los peregrinos de Emaús y ellos le reconocerán en la fracción del pan. En la vivencia de estos frutos de la resurrección, la paz, la alegría, la fe, el entendimiento, podremos evaluar cómo estamos viviendo la resurrección de Jesús en nuestra propia resurrección.

Todas esas palabras y experiencias que proclamaremos durante esta semana de Pascua, son una invitación a creer en El. La fe es el alimento del alma, el creer en Jesús nos ayuda estar fuertes en los momentos de duda, en los momentos de falta de fe, en los momentos de tribulaciones y dificultades, por ello como Juan, también nosotros tenemos que darnos cuenta de que el sepulcro está vacío, que Jesús ha resucitado y tenemos que correr a proclamarlo, la Iglesia nos envía, Jesús nos envía a proclamar que nuestro Dios, es un Dios de vivos, y que Jesús está vivo.

Que Dios nos bendiga a todos.
