



The Holy Spirit will remind you
of everything I have said to you.

A beautiful way to see the presence of our Trinitarian God throughout the history of salvation is when we see God the Father as the creator of the universe and human beings. We see God the Son as the Redeemer; Jesus, with his death and resurrection, redeems us from our sin. And we see the Holy Spirit as the Sanctifier. The work and action of God can be seen very clearly throughout the history of salvation. The creation was the time of God the Creator. Jesus' mission lasted from His Incarnation to His Resurrection and Ascension into heaven. That is the time of God the Redeemer. And from Pentecost until the present, it is the time of God the Holy Spirit, the Sanctifier, the time of the Holy Spirit who guides and leads our Catholic Church.

That is why on this Sixth Sunday of Easter, we hear Jesus saying goodbye to his apostles and promising the coming of the Holy Spirit. He tells us, "I have spoken while I was still with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have said to you". In addition, He gives us the gift of peace and invites us not to be afraid. No doubt this message of Jesus is for today and is addressed to every one of us.

Indeed, each of us has already received the Holy Spirit on the day we were baptized. In the name of Christ, the priest baptized us in "the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." The Holy Spirit gift was confirmed when we received the Sacrament of confirmation. And, through the anointing of the Bishop, Jesus also said, "Receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." So not only at Pentecost, when the apostles together with Mary were gathered in prayer, the Holy Spirit came upon believers, but in the experience of these two sacraments, Baptism and Confirmation, we receive the promise of Jesus, the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Liturgically speaking, the Easter season will close with the feast of Pentecost, which we will celebrate in two weeks. Today's Gospel reminds us that Jesus' promise is an invitation to have peace in our hearts and no fear of his return to the Father. Through his Ascension, which we will celebrate next Thursday, we will open ourselves to the action of the Holy Spirit in our lives, in our families, and our church. This preparation, above all, demands an act of faith, believing in Jesus, believing in his return to the father, that He will not leave us alone but will send us the defender, the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth.

My brothers and sisters, let us prepare ourselves to renew the coming of the Holy Spirit in us. As at Pentecost, let us prepare to be filled with his light, wisdom, and gifts. As in our baptism and Confirmation, let us once be filled with that sanctifying grace that encourages us to live our faith. Let us live as sons and daughters of God, followers of Jesus, members of our Catholic Church, and members of Saint Mary Gate of Heaven Parish.

May God the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit fill us with grace.

El Espíritu Santo les recordara
todo cuanto yo les he dicho.

Una forma hermosa de ver la presencia de nuestro Dios uno y Trino a lo largo de la Historia de la Salvación es cuando ubicamos a Dios padre como el Dios creador, creador del universo, del hombre. A Dios Hijo, como el redentor, Jesús que con su muerte y resurrección nos redime del pecado, y al Espíritu Santo, como el Dios Santificador. Esta obra y acción de Dios la podemos ver muy clara a lo largo de la historia de la Salvación, y podemos decir que, de la creación a la encarnación, fue el tiempo de Dios Creador. La misión de Jesús la ubicamos durante ese periodo evangelizador, que comprende el periodo desde la Encarnación hasta la Resurrección – Ascensión de Jesús. Y desde Pentecostés, hasta nuestros días, el tiempo de Dios Santificador, la acción del Espíritu Santo, quien guía y conduce a nuestra Iglesia Católica.

Es por ello por lo que en este VI Domingo de Pascua, escuchamos a Jesús despidiéndose de sus apóstoles, y prometiéndonos la venida del Espíritu Santo. Y nos dice, "Les he hablado de esto ahora que estoy con ustedes, pero el Defensor, el Espíritu Santo, que enviará el Padre en mi nombre, será quien les enseñe todo y les recuerde todo lo que les he dicho". Además de prometernos al Espíritu Santo, nos ofrece el don de la paz, y nos invita a no tener miedo, a no acobardarnos y se despie. Sin duda este mensaje de Jesús es un mensaje muy actual y dirigido a todos y cada uno de nosotros.

Ciertamente todos y cada uno de nosotros hemos recibido ya el Espíritu Santo el día que fuimos bautizados, ya que el sacerdote en el nombre de Cristo nos bautizó en "el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo", ese Espíritu Santo, fue confirmado el día que recibimos el sacramento de la confirmación. Y por medio de la unción del Obispo, también Jesucristo nos dijo "Recibe el don del Espíritu Santo". De modo que no solo en Pentecostés, cuando los apóstoles juntamente con María se encontraban reunidos en oración, vino el Espíritu Santo sobre ellos, sino en la vivencia de estos dos sacramentos, Bautismo y Confirmación, nosotros recibimos esa promesa de Jesús, el don del Espíritu Santo.

Litúrgicamente hablando, el tiempo Pascual se cierra con la solemnidad de Pentecostés que celebraremos dentro de dos semanas, por eso el evangelio de hoy nos recuerda esa promesa de Jesús. Nos invita a tener paz en el interior de nuestro corazón, a no tener miedo de su regreso al Padre, es decir su Ascensión que celebraremos el próximo jueves. Sino más bien, abrirlnos a la acción del Espíritu Santo en nuestra vida y en nuestra Iglesia. Esta preparación ante todo nos exige el acto de la fe, creer en Jesús, creer en su retorno al padre, pero creer también creer que no nos deja solos, sino que nos envía al Defensor, es decir al Espíritu de Verdad.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, preparamos a renovar la venida de ese Espíritu Santo, que así como en Pentecostés nos llene de su luz, de su sabiduría, de sus dones, Y también que así como en nuestro bautismo y nuestra confirmación, nos llene de esa gracia santificante, que nos anime a vivir nuestra vida de fe como hijos e hijas de Dios, como seguidores y seguidoras de Jesús, como miembros de nuestra Iglesia Católica, como miembros de nuestra parroquia Santa María Puerta del Cielo, solo así hacemos vida la gracia que nos ofrece nuestro Dios Espíritu Santo, quien juntamente con el Padre y el Hijo nos llenan de sus bendiciones.

Que Dios Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo nos llene de gracia.




