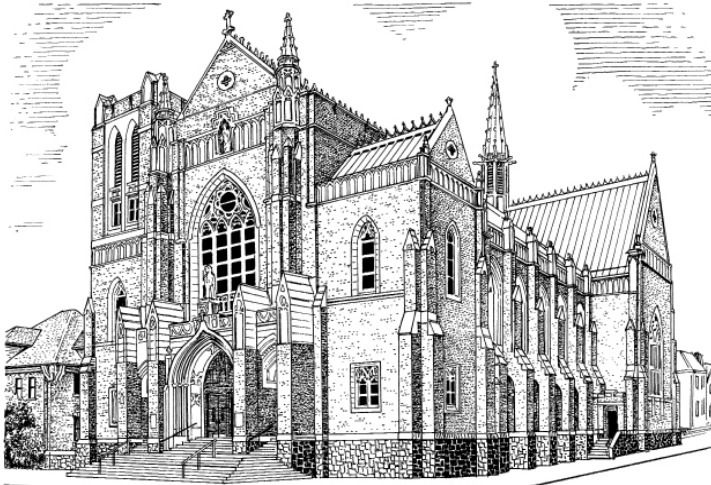

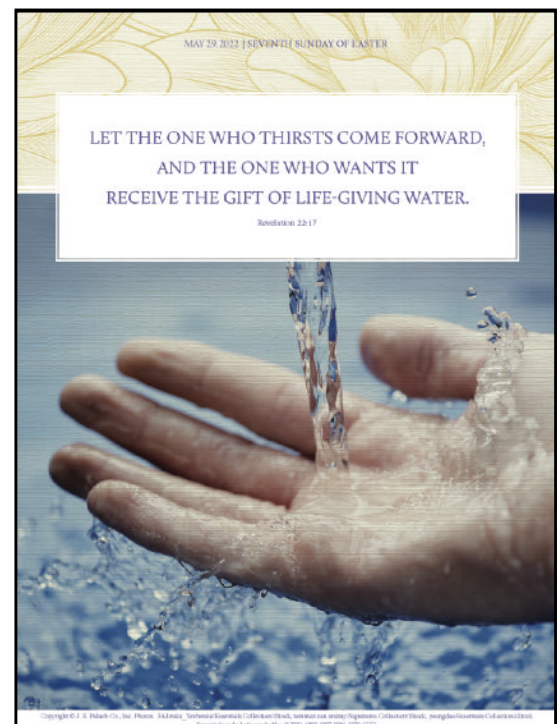

Jesus prays to the Father for his disciples.


The Gospel of this Seventh Sunday of Easter is the so-called “Priesthood Prayer of Jesus” before heading to the Garden of Olives. It reflects the mood of the Lord and the apostles on the night of the Last Supper. In these words, the heart of Christ appears to us to be entirely open and fraternal. It is time for great confidence. The gospel passage is part of Jesus’ personal prayer, called the “priestly prayer.” He is conversing simply and spontaneously with the Father. Through the tone of the words, one can see Jesus’ footprint. This moment of prayer is one of the most intense moments of the Master’s life. Jesus’ petitions in this prayer allow us to see the care and love He has for his apostles, for his disciples, and us: “Holy Father, keep in your name the ones you have given me, that they may be one like us.” Jesus clarifies that the union between him and the apostles will not be simple friendship, something that ends in feelings. He asks of them an intimate unity, like divine unity. Jesus asks that even as they continue in the world, they would stay away from the temptations the world presents as He did. Jesus asks that they be totally consecrated to God, like Him, and be his envoys in the world.

In the other apostles, there will be that fulfilled joy in the one who receives the word, accepts it, and puts it into practice. “I pray to you not to remove them from the world but to keep them from evil.” Rather than asking for their removal from their current environment, he asks for their perseverance against the evil world. Their mission is to be in the world as yeast should be inside the dough. However, they need help from God to persevere against evil as the world will hate them, and it will not be easy to bear the hatred of others. We are aware that, even today, persecution continues against our Christian brothers and sisters in many parts of the world. Jesus prays for the apostles and these our brothers and sisters. He asks for their sanctification: “Sanctify them in the truth,” as sanctifying is to consecrate. What Jesus asks for them is not simple aid but rather a true inner transformation. He does not ask that they dedicate themselves to the service of the truth; he asks for their transformation by the Truth with a capital letter. He asks God to make them his own – that God consecrate them.

Jesus’ prayer is always effective as whatever he asks is realized. In the light of these words, we better understand Priestly Ordination, performed in this same Holy Thursday supper. The entire ministry of Jesus was, in favor of the chosen apostles, a prolonged ordination. Moreover, at the Sacred Supper, this priestly prayer was the culmination of this ordination. Jesus points out the extent and reality of the powers, the sanctity of the bonds, and the unity that results from it. Jesus is present, more than ever, as the great priest consecrating other priests, his apostles, and us by our baptism.

We know the Apostles barely got the idea. The fears and shortness of their intelligence, personal ambitions, and selfish quarrels prevented them from discovering what was happening in their souls. Nevertheless, Jesus’ Resurrection and the coming of the Holy Spirit illuminated what they had hardly guessed. Then they remembered and rebuilt what had happened on that holy night. That is why they took to the world. They took the bread in their hands and handed it to the new believers, confident that Jesus’ strength acted in them. Thousands of priests would repeat that same gesture throughout history, the same fragility, with the same power. Therefore, in every Eucharist, we celebrate together that Jesus continues to pray for us.

May God bless us all.

Jesús ruega al Padre por sus discípulos.

El Evangelio de este VII Domingo de Pascua, nos habla de la oración sacerdotal de Jesús, antes de encaminarse hacia el huerto de los olivos. Se refleja en él el clima anímico que debieron tener el Señor y los apóstoles, la noche de la Última Cena. En estas palabras, el corazón de Cristo se nos muestra enteramente abierto y fraternal. Es la hora de las grandes confidencias. El pasaje del evangelio es parte de una oración personal de Jesús, llamada la oración sacerdotal. Está conversando en forma sencilla y espontánea con el Padre. En todo el tono de las palabras se nota la huella de Jesús. Se trata de uno de los momentos más intensos de la vida del Maestro. Las peticiones de Jesús en su oración nos dejan ver ese cuidado y amor por sus apóstoles, por sus discípulos y por nosotros “Padre santo, guarda en tu nombre a estos que me has dado, para que sean uno como nosotros”. Jesús aclara que la unión entre él y los apóstoles no es una simple amistad, algo que termina en el sentimiento. Pide para ellos una unidad tan íntima como la unidad divina. Pide que, aunque sigan en el mundo, estén separados de esas tentaciones que el mundo nos presenta, como Él mismo lo está. Pide que, como Él, estén totalmente consagrados a Dios y sean sus enviados en el mundo. En estas peticiones al Padre quedan definidos la razón de ser de la Iglesia y todo el nuevo orden de la Iglesia.

En los demás apóstoles habrá esa alegría cumplida que hay en quien recibe la palabra, la acepta y la pone en práctica. “No ruego que los retires del mundo, sino que los guardes del mal”. No pide que sean sacados de su ambiente, no pide que se les preserve del mundo, hacen falta en el mundo, ahí está su misión. La levadura debe estar en medio de la masa. Pero necesitan ayuda de Dios para ser preservados del mal. Porque el mundo los aborrecerá y no será fácil soportar el odio de los demás. Todos somos conscientes que incluso en nuestros días, sigue habiendo persecuciones contra nuestros hermanos cristianos en muchas partes del mundo, por los apóstoles y por estos hermanos nuestros es que Jesús oro y pide que sean santificados. “Santifícalos en la verdad”, santificar equivale a consagrar. Lo que pide Jesús no es una simple ayuda para los suyos. Pide una auténtica transformación interior. No pide que se dediquen al servicio de la verdad, pide que sean transformados por la Verdad, con mayúscula. Pide que Dios los haga suyos, pide que sean consagrados por Dios.

La oración de Jesús es siempre eficaz. Obra lo que dice. A la luz de estas palabras entendemos mejor la ordenación sacerdotal que se realizó en esta misma cena del jueves santo. Todo el ministerio de Jesús fue, en favor de los apóstoles elegidos, como una prolongada ordenación. Y esta oración sacerdotal, en el momento de la sagrada cena, es el punto culminante de esta ordenación. Jesús señala la extensión y la realidad de los poderes, la santidad de los lazos y la unidad que resulta de ella. Jesús se presenta, en este momento más que nunca, como el gran sacerdote que consagra a otros sacerdotes, a sus apóstoles y que nos consagra a todos nosotros por nuestro bautismo.

Sabemos que ellos apenas se enteraron. El miedo y lo corto de sus inteligencias, sus ambiciones personales y sus rencillas egoístas, todo les impedía descubrir lo que estaba ocurriendo en sus almas. Pero la resurrección iluminó lo que apenas habían intuido. Entonces recordaron y reconstruyeron lo que esa noche santa había ocurrido. Por eso se lanzaron a los caminos del mundo. Por eso tomaban el pan entre las manos y lo repartían a los nuevos creyentes, seguros de que la fuerza de Jesús actuaba en ellos. Miles y miles de sacerdotes repetirían a lo largo de la historia ese mismo gesto, con la misma fragilidad, con el mismo poder. Y así sucede en cada Eucaristía que celebramos juntos. Jesús sigue orando por nosotros.

Que Dios nos bendiga a todos.


