**All that belongs to the Father is mine.
The Spirit will guide you into all the truth.**

**Todo lo que es del Padre es mío,
el Espíritu Santo les guiará hasta la verdad plena.**

Each year, on the Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the Sunday of the Holy Trinity. After celebrating Jesus' Resurrection and listening to his farewell words to his apostles, he insisted on his provenance and the origin of its mission. He clearly expressed everything He said or did he received from His father. We now see that image of our three-in-one, or triune, God. Therefore, the Word of this Sunday leaves us with the Trinitarian image. Jesus tells us in today's gospel, "All that belongs to the Father is mine. The Spirit will guide you into all the truth. He will glorify me because it is from me that he will receive what he will make known to you." We've heard Jesus say this before. So, if the Holy Spirit takes everything that belongs to Jesus, and everything that belongs to Jesus belongs to the Father, we see the Trinitarian communion.

We often tend to think that our triune God is a mystery, and indeed, it is, but we cannot be satisfied with that answer, we need to reflect on the meaning of that uniqueness and Trinitarian unity. Throughout history, we see each of the three divine persons at work. From creation to the Incarnation, we see the work of God the Father. From the Incarnation to the Ascension, we see the work of God the Son. And from Pentecost until today, we see the work of God the Holy Spirit. So, we identify God the Creator (the Father), God the Redeemer (Jesus), and the Sanctifying God (the Holy Spirit). But we know that when the Father acts, the Son and the Holy Spirit work with him. When God the Son works, the Father and the Holy Spirit work with Him; when the Holy Spirit works, The Father and Son act with Him. We see the oneness and that Trinitarian unity.

Now we realize that the essence of God is communion — the communion we see in this oneness and Trinitarian unity. Jesus explained that very well in His priestly prayer in the last days before Easter. When Jesus prayed for the unity of the one Church and gave us as an example of the unity He has with His Father, and promised the Holy Spirit, he implicitly spoke about that oneness and Trinitarian unity.

Another aspect of this Trinitarian unity is the different divine relationships. There are four relations in God, which are given by the relative diversity of Persons, which does not break the unity of nature because wherever one of them is, the other two are as well. Thus, we see the first relation of Paternity, the Father regarding the Son. Another relation is the Parental relationship — the relation of the Son regarding the Father, from all eternity, by way of intellectual knowledge. The last is the relationship of Active Expiration. This means that the Father and the Son love each other, generating a new person, the Holy Spirit. Voluntarily, they actively breathe out love. And the last relationship is the relationship called Passive Breath. It is exhaled Love for the Father and the Son as seen by the Holy Spirit. Since He who receives and is generated, the expiration of the Father and the Son is received. Therefore, it is a passive exhalation.

That communion and relationship of the three divine persons is something that each one of us who profess our faith in the God of Jesus Christ continually must fight to live. The Church must be the image of this communion, of this relationship. We must live that relationship, that Trinitarian communion. My brothers and sisters, let us ask our Triune God to give us the grace to live that unity, that communion, and above all, the love that should identify us as sons and daughters of God, as followers of Jesus, under the action of the Holy Spirit.

Come Holy Spirit, and fill the hearts of your faithful!

Cada año, el domingo después de Pentecostés celebramos el Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad, después de haber estado celebrando la Resurrección de Jesús, y escuchando sus palabras de despedida a sus apóstoles, donde Él nos insistió mucho su procedencia, el origen de su misión, donde nos expresó muy claro que todo lo que él decía o hacía, lo había recibido de su Padre, vemos así, esa imagen de nuestro Dios uno y trino. Por ello en su palabra de este domingo también se deja ver esa imagen trinitaria, por un lado, Jesús nos dice "todo lo que es del Padre es mío", también dice "cuando venga El, el Espíritu de la verdad, los guiará a la verdad plena. El me glorificará, porque recibirá de lo mío y se lo comunicará a ustedes", y si Jesús anteriormente nos había dicho que "todo lo que es del Padre es de Él, y el Espíritu Santo tomara todo lo que es de Él". Se deja ver muy claro la comunión de ese Dios trinitario.

Muchas veces tendemos a responder que nuestro Dios Uno y Trino es un misterio, y ciertamente lo es, pero no podemos quedarnos solo con esa respuesta, tenemos que reflexionar que significa esa unicidad y unidad trinitaria. Es claro que a lo largo de la historia vemos la obra de cada una de las divinas personas obrando y actuando en cada ser y en la comunidad entera. Desde la creación hasta la Encarnación vemos claro la obra de Dios Padre. Desde la Encarnación hasta la Ascensión, vemos la obra del Dios Hijo. Y desde Pentecostés hasta nuestros días, vemos la obra de Dios Espíritu Santo. Así identificamos al Dios creador, al Dios redentor, y al Dios Santificador, pero cuando obra el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo obran con El. Cuando obra Dios Hijo, el Padre y el Espíritu Santo obran con El y cuando obra Dios Espíritu Santo, el Padre y el Hijo obran con El. Se deja ver clara esa unicidad y esa unidad trinitaria.

Lo que nos revela esa unicidad y unidad trinitaria es la comunión de personas, por ello afirmarnos que la esencia de Dios es comunión. Jesús nos lo explico muy bien en esa oración sacerdotal que escuchamos en los últimos días de la Pascua, cuando oro por la unidad de la Iglesia y puso como ejemplo esa unidad de El con el Padre y con el Espíritu Santo.

También vemos que otra característica de esta unidad trinitaria, es las distintas relaciones divinas. Hay cuatro relaciones en Dios, que se dan mediante la oposición relativa de las Personas, lo que no rompa su Unidad de naturaleza, porque donde está Una de Ellas están también las otras Dos. Así vemos la Paternidad del Padre con referencia al Hijo, es la primera relación. La relación de Filiación del Hijo con referencia al Padre, de quien procede desde toda la eternidad por vía de conocimiento intelectual. La relación Espiración Activa, el Padre y el Hijo se aman de tal manera que generan una nueva persona, el Espíritu Santo, por vía volitiva, espiran activamente el Amor. Y la relación llamada Espiración Pasiva, es el Amor espirado por el Padre y el Hijo contemplado desde el Espíritu Santo, desde Él, que recibe y es generado, la espiración del Padre y del Hijo es recibida, por lo tanto, es una espiración pasiva.

Esa comunión y relación de las tres divinas personas, es algo que todos y cada uno de nosotros, los que profesamos nuestra fe en el Dios de Jesucristo hemos de luchar por vivir continuamente. La Iglesia tiene que ser imagen de esa comunión, de esa relación, de ese amor y al ser nosotros quienes conformamos nuestra Iglesia, nosotros tenemos que vivir esa relación, amor y comunión trinitaria. Pidámosle a Dios uno y trino que nos de su gracia para poder vivir esa unidad, esa comunión y sobre todo el amor que nos ha de identificar como hijos e hijas de Dios, como seguidores de Jesús, bajo la acción del Espíritu Santo.

Que Dios Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo nos llene de gracia.
