



...A Reflection from our Pastor...

...Reflexión de nuestro Pastor...

They all ate and were satisfied.

The Gospels present two scenes from the multiplication of the loaves made by Jesus. The First Multiplication of the Loaves can be seen in four "parallel" texts written by the four evangelists. It is in the Gospel of Matthew in Chapter 14: 13-21, in Mark in Chapter 6: 30-44, in Luke in Chapter 9: 10-17, and in John in Chapter 6: 1-15. Like the first, the second miracle also occurs on a mountain by the Sea of Galilee. For three days, a crowd followed the Master, who healed "lame people, crippled, blind, mute, and many others." Again, Jesus had compassion for those who had been so loyal to him. He wanted to feed them because many had come from afar and could collapse on the way. Taking seven loaves, He gave thanks, broke them, and gave them to his disciples to pass them around to people, who were about four thousand men, again without counting women and children. Then Jesus got into a boat and moved to the region of Magadan. We find this in Mark 8: 1-10.

The multiplication of loaves and fish has been seen as a foreshadowing of or anticipation of the Eucharist. On this Twelfth Sunday of Ordinary Time, we also celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord, also known as Corpus Christi. Usually, in this Solemnity, we proclaim the institution of the Eucharist, but this year we listen to the multiplication of loaves as told by the evangelist Luke. As mentioned, this multiplication of loaves and fish helps us see the meaning of the Institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. At the Last Supper, Jesus offered himself as food, offering his body and blood for us, as the Gospel tells us, "As they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, broke it, and gave to his disciples, and said, 'Take and eat; this is my body.' He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them saying, 'Drink of it all of you for this is my blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the forgiveness of sins.'" (Matthew 26: 26-28).

In the multiplication of the loaves, Jesus shows us how He multiplies bread to satisfy the hunger of all those with him. In the Last Supper, Jesus made himself food and confirmed his words in the Institution of the Eucharist and his death on the cross. The effects of the Eucharist in each of us are also to satisfy us when we receive Him in the Holy Communion. Jesus himself satiates our hunger and thirst, not biologically, as in the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves, but specifically our spiritual hunger and thirst. Upon receiving Jesus' Body and Blood, He relieves every hunger, loneliness, existential emptiness, sadness, and everything that makes us feel spiritual hunger and thirst.

Jesus keeps multiplying loaves, continues multiplying himself in every Eucharist, and continues giving himself as our food for our way. For this reason, we are invited not only to participate in the Eucharist but, above all, to partake in Communion, to receive Him. Participating in the Eucharist without receiving the body of Christ lacks something — the most critical aspect — the food. If you are a person who receives communion in the celebration of the Eucharist, blessed be God. But if you're not, I invite you to reflect. I encourage you to get ready to receive it, either through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, preparing to receive the Sacrament of Eucharist, or getting ready to receive the sacrament of marriage so that you can participate fully in this sacred moment, the multiplication of bread, the multiplication of Jesus in the Eucharistic.

May God bless us all.

Todos comieron y quedaron satisfechos.

Los evangelios nos presentan dos escenas de la multiplicación de los panes realizadas por Jesús. La primera multiplicación de los panes puede apreciarse en cuatro textos "paralelos", escrito por cada uno de los cuatro evangelistas. En el Evangelio de Mateo está en el capítulo 14,13-21. En Marcos: capítulo 6,30-44. En Lucas: capítulo 9,10-17. En Juan: 6,1-15. Como el primero, el segundo milagro también tiene lugar en una montaña a orillas del mar de Galilea. Una multitud estuvo durante tres días siguiendo al Maestro, quien curó a "paralíticos, lisiados, ciegos, mudos y muchos otros enfermos". Otra vez, Jesús tuvo compasión de la gente que le había sido tan fiel, y quería darles de comer ya que muchos habían venido de lejos y podían desfallecer en el camino. Tomando siete panes, dio las gracias, los partió, y los dio a sus discípulos para que a su vez los repartieran a la gente, que eran unos cuatro mil hombres, otra vez sin contar mujeres y niños. Luego Jesús se subió a una barca y se trasladó a la región de Magadán, lo encontramos en Mr. 8,1-10.

Estas multiplicaciones de panes y pescados siempre han sido vistas como prefiguración de la Eucaristía, o como anticipación de esta. Este domingo XII del Tiempo Ordinario, celebramos también la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre del Señor, conocido también como Corpus Cristi. Generalmente en esta solemnidad proclamamos la institución de la Eucaristía, pero este año hemos escuchado la multiplicación de los panes que nos narra el evangelista San Lucas. Porque como lo indicaba anteriormente esta multiplicación de panes y peces, nos deja ver muy claro lo que luego significaría la institución de la Eucaristía en la última cena. En la última cena, Jesús se hace alimento, ya que nos dice el evangelio, "Y comiendo ellos, tomó Jesús el pan y lo bendijo lo partió, y dio a sus discípulos, y dijo: Tomen, y coman. Esto es mi cuerpo. Y tomando la copa, y hechas gracias, les dio, diciendo: Beban de él todos; Porque esto es mi sangre del nuevo pacto, la cual es derramada por muchos para remisión de los pecados." (Mateo 26,26-28).

La multiplicación de los panes nos muestra como Jesús se hace alimento y sacia el hambre de todos aquellos que estaban con El. Ese hacerse alimento luego Él lo confirmará con sus palabras en la institución de la Eucaristía y en su muerte en la cruz. El efecto de la Eucaristía en todos y cada uno de nosotros que le recibimos en la comunión, es que Jesús mismo sacia nuestra hambre y sed, no biológicamente, como sucedió en el milagro de la multiplicación de los panes, sino sobre todo nuestra hambre y sed espiritual. Al recibir a Jesús en su cuerpo y en su sangre, el sacia toda hambre, tal como la soledad, el vacío existencial, las tristezas, todo aquello que nos hace sentir hambre y sed espiritual. Así como alimentamos el cuerpo, cuando este nos pide algo a través del hambre, también tenemos que alimentar el espíritu recibiendo a Jesús en la comunión eucarística.

Sin duda, que El sigue multiplicando panes, sigue multiplicándose El mismo en cada Eucaristía, y sigue dándose y ofreciéndose como nuestro alimento para este caminar por la vida. Por ello, somos invitados no solo a participar de la Eucaristía, sino sobre todo a participar de la comunión, recibirla a Él. Participar en la Eucaristía sin recibir el cuerpo de Cristo, a nuestra participación le falta algo, le falta lo más importante, le falta el alimento. Si eres una persona que se alimenta de Jesús Eucaristía bendito Dios, si no lo eres, te invito a reflexionar, y ojalá te anime a prepararte para recibirla, sea por medio del sacramento de la reconciliación, preparándose para recibir la comunión, o preparándose para recibir el sacramento del matrimonio y así poder participar plenamente de este momento de multiplicación del pan, de este momento eucarístico.

Que Dios nos bendiga a todos.
