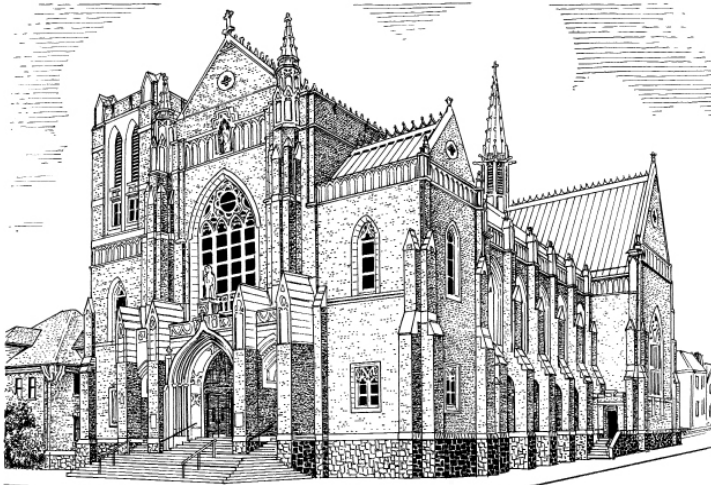

**“Love the Lord your God with all your heart
and with all your soul and with all your strength
and with all your mind. And, Love your neighbor as yourself.”**

Our Catholic Christian faith is a faith with a vertical and a horizontal dimension. In its vertical dimension, we are invited to respond to God’s love for us. The first three commandments of God’s law relate to fulfilling our duties to God. The Lord’s Prayer’s first sentence also recognizes God’s greatness. In the horizontal dimension, we are invited to love, to serve our neighbor and those around us. The last seven commandments of God’s law are rules and regulations that show how we should love and serve one another as brothers and sisters. The second part of the Our Father expresses four petitions to God, which invite us to forgive and to have a good relationship and fellowship with our brothers and sisters. The gospel is full of Jesus’ words that ask us to love, serve, forgive, reconcile, experience fraternal correction, and help our brothers and sisters. Such is the case of the Gospel of this XV Sunday in Ordinary Time, where Jesus offers us a beautiful lesson through the Christian commandment: to love God and our neighbor. He says we “Shall love the Lord thy God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your soul. And love your neighbor as yourself.”

The teacher of the law in today’s gospel wanted to set a trap, but Jesus knew what they were thinking in their hearts and gave a great lesson with the Parable of the Good Samaritan. Indeed, we all have heard many times this beautiful parable. However, the most beautiful thing is Jesus’ teaching on love of neighbor. More than ever, our present world, divided by hatred, wars, differences, religious fanaticism, organized crime, broken marriages, and broken families, urges us to heed Jesus in the invitation to love and serve others. Spaces and places we have many, above all, the family atmosphere. Broken families, separations, and divorces of our couples demand us the urgent need to implement the teachings of Jesus about love, especially for those closer to each of us, as husband and wife, father and mother, and children as well. In the family, we must first implement this teaching of Jesus about love. Our environment is another area where Jesus calls us to be witnesses of the love of God, looking for friendly relations, overcoming envy, rancor, and insults of our society.

Loving our neighbor is nothing less than putting God’s mercy into practice. God is the one who loves us and forgives us first. He is the one who put his heart into our human misery and invites us to do the same. It is an opportunity that God and the Church give us to live that message to love our neighbor. My brothers and sisters, let us reflect on this invitation of Jesus, and let us strive to implement the law that Jesus offers us in today’s gospel “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind; and love your neighbor as yourself.”

May God bless us all.

**“Amaras al Señor, tu Dios con todo tu corazón
y con toda tu alama y con todas tus fuerzas
y con todo tu ser. Y a tu prójimo como a ti mismo”.**

Nuestra fe cristiano católica es una fe con una dimensión vertical y una dimensión horizontal. En su dimensión vertical, somos invitados a responder al amor que Dios nos tiene, los primeros tres mandamientos de la ley de Dios se refieren a ese cumplimiento de nuestros deberes para con Dios. La primera parte de la oración del padre nuestro también son expresiones que reconocen la grandeza de Dios. En su dimensión horizontal somos invitados a amar, a servir a nuestro prójimo, a los que nos rodean. Los últimos siete mandamientos de la ley de Dios, son normas y leyes que nos indican cómo hemos de amarnos y servirnos los unos a los otros como hermanos. La segunda parte del Padre Nuestro expresa cuatro peticiones a Dios y entre ellas hay algunas que nos invitan al perdón, y a la buena relación y convivencia con los hermanos. El evangelio está lleno de palabras de Jesús que nos invitan al amor, al servicio, al perdón, a la reconciliación, a la corrección fraterna, a la ayuda a nuestros hermanos y hermanas. Tal es el caso del evangelio de este Domingo XV del Tiempo Ordinario, donde Jesús nos ofrece una bella lección de quien es el prójimo ofreciéndonos la ley del cristiano, “Amaras al Señor, tu Dios. Con todo tu corazón y con toda tu alma y con todas tus fuerzas y con todo tu ser. Y a tu prójimo como a ti mismo”.

El maestro de la ley le quería poner una trampa, sin embargo Jesús sabiendo lo que intuía en su corazón, le da una gran lección de amor al prójimo con la parábola del buen samaritano. Seguramente todos hemos escuchado muchas veces esta hermosa parábola, pero todavía más, lo más hermoso es la misma enseñanza de Jesús sobre el amor al prójimo. En este mundo dividido por el odio, las guerras, las diferencias, el fanatismo religioso, el crimen organizado, los matrimonios desunidos, las familias desintegradas, más que nunca, nos urge hacerle caso a Jesús en esa invitación a amar, a servir al prójimo. Espacios y lugares, tenemos muchos, ante todo el ambiente familiar, frente a las familias desintegradas, las separaciones y divorcios, urge poner en práctica el amor al prójimo, especialmente con aquel más próximo a cada uno de nosotros, como lo es un esposo, la esposa, papa, mama, los hijos. Es ahí en la familia donde primero tenemos que poner en práctica esta enseñanza de Jesús sobre el amor. El ambiente donde trabajamos es otro espacio para ser testimonios del amor de Dios, buscando las relaciones amistosas frente a las envidias, rencores y ofensas que muchas veces experimentamos en nuestros ambientes de trabajo.

El amor al prójimo no es otra cosa que poner en práctica la misericordia de Dios. Él es quien nos amó y perdonó primero, es El, quien, poniendo su corazón en nuestras miserias humanas, nos invita a salir, a levantarnos, a resolver diferencias a partir del amor, del perdón, del diálogo, del respeto. Es una oportunidad que Dios y la Iglesia nos dan para hacer vida ese mensaje del amor al prójimo. Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, reflexionemos en esta invitación de Jesús, y luchemos por poner en practica esa ley que nos ofrece Jesús hoy, “Amaras al Señor, tu Dios. Con todo tu corazón y con toda tu alama y con todas tus fuerzas y con todo tu ser. Y a tu prójimo como a ti mismo”.

Que Dios nos bendiga.
