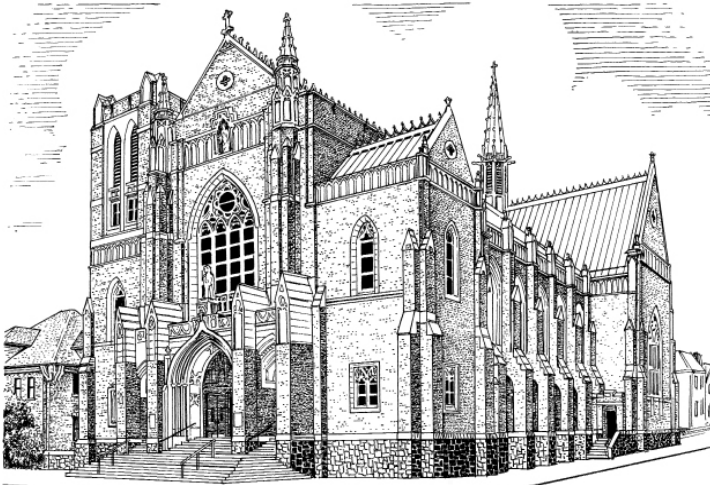

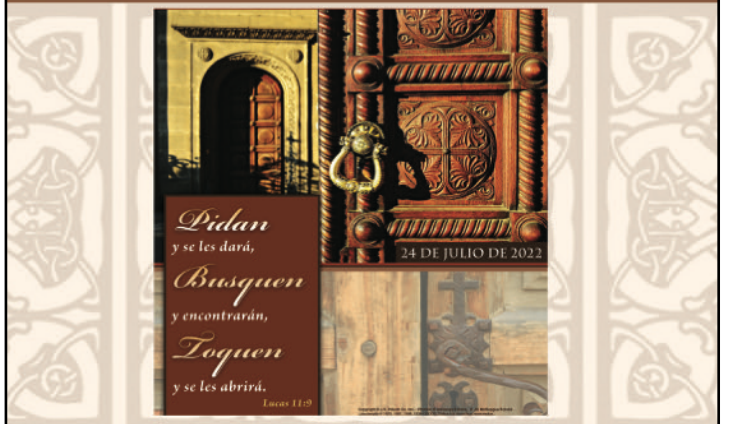

Ask, and you will receive.

The human being results from integrating the physical and the spiritual being. So that, as each of us takes care of our body and seeks to respond to its needs. If we are hungry, we eat. If we feel cold, we cover ourselves. If we are sick, we go to see the doctor. We address our human needs. We must also take care of our spiritual beings. Our spirit also needs to be cared for, to be fed. Prayer is one of those fundamental foods of our spiritual life. Without prayer, our spiritual being is dying. That is why in the Gospel of this Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus invites us to be in communion with God our Father, under the action of the Holy Spirit, through prayer.


The Lord's Prayer is the model of Christian prayer. After recognizing the greatness and nearness of God, calling him "Our Father," we recognize three fundamental elements of his divine greatness. We proclaim that Hallowed is his name, ask that his kingdom comes to us, and that His will be done in us. As we see, in these expressions, above all, we focus on Him and recognize who He is for us. In the second part of this prayer, we focus on us, and we ask, first for our daily bread, not just the material bread but also the spiritual bread, above all, the bread of the Eucharist, the bread of His Word, the bread of prayer.

On the other hand, we ask forgiveness for our mistakes and errors. But with this apology, we also offer to forgive those who have offended us. So, this request requires commitment, being able to forgive others' mistakes and wrongs. We ask that He leads us not into temptation. Evil is present in many ways and continually tries to make us fall. And above all, we also ask to be delivered from evil, immersed as we are in our world and society where evil is present in different ways. We ask God to save us from the different faces of evil.

In today's gospel, Jesus also asks us to be consistent and persistent in our prayer. He encourages us not to be discouraged at first. We get discouraged and stop praying when we don't get the expected answer. In the parable of the person who went to ask his friend for a piece of bread to help another friend and met the resistance of this friend who did not want to get up, he insists until he gets what he wants. Jesus teaches us that in prayer, we must be insistent, that we need not grow weary or lose heart, but we must insist. In prayer, we must never get tired of talking to God, glorifying Him, giving thanks for what we received from Him, and asking and expressing our needs. Only through prayer do we communicate with Him and experience his love for us. And, before we ask Him for something, He already knows what we need, but He wants us to talk with Him, to communicate with Him.

My brothers and sisters, let's listen to Jesus, be men and women of prayer, be men and women of God and remain in continuous union with the God who will undoubtedly respond to our needs when we pray from our hearts.

May God bless us all.

Los seres humanos somos esa integración de nuestro ser corporal y nuestro ser espiritual. De modo que, así como cada uno de nosotros cuida su cuerpo, y busca responder a sus necesidades, es decir, si tenemos hambre comemos, si tenemos frío nos cubrimos, si estamos enfermos vamos a ver al médico. Así tenemos que cuidar también nuestro espíritu. Nuestro ser espiritual también necesita ser cuidado, ser alimentado. La oración es uno de esos alimentos fundamentales de nuestra vida espiritual, sin oración, nuestro ser espiritual se muere. Es por ello por lo que en el evangelio de este Domingo XVII del Tiempo Ordinario Jesús nos invita a estar en comunión con nuestro Padre Dios y con El mismo, bajo la acción del Espíritu Santo, a través de la oración.

La oración del "Padre Nuestro", es el modelo de oración cristiana, después de reconocer la grandeza y cercanía de Dios, al grado de llamarlo "Padre". Reconocemos en El tres elementos fundamentales de su grandeza divina, expresamos que sean santificado su nombre, que venga a nosotros su reino, y que se cumpla en nosotros su voluntad. Como podemos ver, en estas expresiones ante todo nos centramos en El, y nos dirigimos a Él reconociendo quien es El para nosotros. En la segunda parte del padre nuestro, nos centramos en nosotros mismos, y le pedimos, ante todo el pan de cada día, no solo el pan corporal, material, sino también el pan espiritual ante todo el pan de la eucaristía, el pan de la palabra, el pan de la oración. Por otro lado, le pedimos perdón por cuantos errores y faltas que hemos cometido, pero con esta petición de perdón, también nosotros nos ofrecemos a perdonar a aquellos que nos haya ofendido, así que esta petición exige un compromiso, aquel de ser capaces de persona a los demás. Le pedimos que no nos deje caer en la tentación, el mal representado en muchas de las cosas que vivimos día a día, se puede manifestar, tentarnos y hacernos caer, desde un enojo, un sentimiento negativo, hasta grandes actitudes y acciones que no nos llevan a destruirnos a nosotros mismos como personas y como hermanos, por ello le pedimos que no nos deje caer en la tentación. Y ante todo también le pedimos que nos libre del mal, inmersos en nuestro mundo y sociedad ese mal se hace presente de distintas maneras, pues le pedimos a Dios nos libre de las distintas caras del maligno.

Después de enseñarnos a orar, Jesús nos pide que seamos constantes e insistentes en nuestra oración, nos anima a no desanimarnos a la primera, muchas veces, cuando no recibimos la respuesta que esperamos, como que nos desanimamos y dejamos de orar. Con la parábola de aquella persona que fue a pedirle a su amigo un pedazo de pan para a su vez el mismo ayudar a otro amigo, y ante la resistencia de este amigo que no quería levantarse para darle el pan que le pedía, Jesús nos enseña que en la oración hemos de ser insistentes, que no tenemos por qué cansarnos o desanimarnos, por el contrario, tenemos que insistir más. En la oración nunca debemos de cansarnos de dialogar, de platicar con Dios, de glorificarlo, de darle gracias, de pedirle, solo a través de la oración estaremos en comunicación con ese Dios que nos ama y que de antemano conoce lo que necesitamos antes de que nosotros se lo pidamos.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, hagámosle caso a Jesús, seamos hombres y mujeres de oración, hombres y mujeres de Dios, y permanezcamos en continua unión con ese Dios que sin duda responderá a nuestras necesidades cuando se las pidamos de corazón.
