



Being rich in the eyes of God

Ser ricos a los ojos de Dios



Jesus' proposal when preaching the good news was especially asking for a renewal of the inner life, an awareness of our being sons and daughters of God, and growth of spiritual life. And that proposal of Jesus is the proposal of our Catholic Church, following the teachings of Jesus. That is why in the Gospel reading of this Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus continues inviting us to store up treasures in heaven and be rich in the eyes of God.

Through the parable of the rich man in today's gospel, a man accumulated a lot of treasures and thought that he could enjoy his life, but, in God's plan, there was already a call for his death, so he would not enjoy his riches. Jesus invites us to understand that we cannot have our eyes and interests on material things, earthly treasures, or riches here on earth because we will not take anything with us on the day of our death. Unfortunately, the world and society continually invite us to a different way of living that Jesus speaks about in today's gospel. Social media encourages us to have, own, and accumulate; sadly, we often value our human existence by what we have accumulated. The value of each human person is not in what you have in material things, in bank accounts, or in property or asset accumulation. The person's beauty and richness are in being God's sons and daughters. It is to become aware of that divine filiation we all have through our faith, our sacramental life, our prayer life, and primarily through living a spiritual life and enrichment.

The accumulation of wealth brings pride, selfishness, power, and vainglory, destroying the person and enslaving us. The more you have, the more you want to have; you will never be satisfied, never feel full, never feel free, because it has made slaves of material things through compulsive shopping and the desire to have. But all those negative emotions and feelings lead to the person's destruction. The person in that way never is satisfied with what we have. In addition, the obsessive desire to possess often leads us to despise others, often considering it unimportant and stepping over the dignity of the human person. We overlook others' interests and do not realize we are exploiting others.

That is why the recommendation of Jesus in the Gospel of this Sunday is clear. Accumulate wealth for the kingdom of God, being rich for God. Jesus invites us to accumulate spiritual wealth. The Gospel invites us to reflect above all on our spiritual life, our sacramental life, our prayer life, our life of service, and generous and selfless dedication. The Church offers us many spaces, opportunities, groups of apostolate, prayer experiences, frequenting the sacraments, and participation in the Eucharist and Reconciliation. We also receive the sacramental grace of marriage for couples who have not, looking to experience service opportunities, helping the poor and needy, and visiting our sick brothers and sisters. My brothers and sisters, let us help each other to enrich ourselves with the things of God, to be rich for God. Let us not become deaf to the invitation of Jesus in today's Gospel, and let us accumulate treasures that would help us be in the presence of God where He has sent us.

May God bless us all.

La predicación de Jesús fue una predicación que sobre todo proponía una renovación de la vida interior, una toma de conciencia de nuestro ser hijos e hijas de Dios, un crecimiento de vida espiritual. Y esa misma propuesta es la propuesta de nuestra Iglesia, siguiendo las enseñanzas de Jesús. Es por ello que en la lectura del evangelio de este XVIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, Jesús nos sigue invitando a acumular tesoros en el cielo y ser ricos a los ojos de Dios. Es decir nos plantea y propone un crecimiento espiritual.

A través de la parábola de ese hombre rico que acumuló una gran cantidad de riquezas, y pensó que ahora si podría darse a la buena vida, pero que en el plan de Dios estaba ya el llamarlo a la resurrección por la muerte, Jesús nos invita a reflexionar que no podemos tener puestos nuestros ojos e intereses en cosas materiales, terrenales, tesoros aquí en la tierra que finalmente el día de nuestra muerte no nos llevaremos nada. Desgraciadamente el mundo y la sociedad que nos está tocando vivir nos plantean una propuesta contraria a la de Jesús. Nos invita a tener, a poseer, a acumular, y tristemente muchas veces nos valoramos por lo mucho o poco que se tiene a nivel material, y ahí es donde vienen los problemas. El valor de cada persona humana no está en el mucho tener cosas materiales, cuentas bancarias, propiedades o acumulación de bienes. La belleza y riqueza de la persona está en ser hijo e hija de Dios, en tomar conciencia de esa filiación divina que todos tenemos por nuestra fe, por nuestra vida sacramental, por nuestra vida de oración, y sobre todo por ese nivel de vida, y enriquecimiento espiritual.

La acumulación de riquezas trae consigo soberbia, egoísmo, poder, vanagloria, y eso destruye a la persona, la esclaviza, por eso el que más tiene, mas quiere tener, y nunca se siente satisfecho, saciado, completo, libre, porque se hace esclavo de las cosas materiales, de las compras obsesivas, del deseo de tener y más tener, pero está claro que todas esas emociones y sentimientos negativos, llevan a la destrucción de la persona, porque nunca se estará conforme con lo que se tiene. Además que el deseo obsesivo de poseer muchas veces lleva a despreciar a los demás, muchas veces no importa pasar por encima de la dignidad de la persona humana, viendo los propios intereses no nos damos cuenta que explotamos a los demás, sin duda que muchos de nosotros experimentamos la explotación al ser personas indocumentadas, y no poder defender nuestros derechos.

Es por ello que la recomendación de Jesús en el evangelio de este domingo es clara, acumular riquezas para el reino de Dios, ser ricos para Dios, y él nos plantea acumular riquezas espirituales. El evangelio nos invita a reflexionar ante todo en nuestra vida espiritual, nuestra vida sacramental, nuestra vida de oración, nuestra vida de servicio y entrega generosa y desinteresada. La misma Iglesia nos ofrece muchos espacios, oportunidades, grupos de apostolado, experiencias de oración, frecuencia de los sacramentos, ante todo la participación en la Eucaristía y en la Reconciliación, recibir la gracia sacramental del matrimonio para los matrimonios que no lo han hecho. Experiencias y oportunidades de servicio, de ayuda a los más pobres y necesitados, a nuestros hermanos y hermanas enfermos. Todo ello mis hermanas y mis hermanos nos ayudan a enriquecernos de las cosas de Dios, a ser ricos para Dios. No nos hagamos sordos a la invitación de Jesús en el evangelio de hoy, y acumulemos tesoros que nos ayuden a ser esa presencia de Dios ahí donde Él nos envía.

Que Dios nos bendiga.




