



...A Reflection from our Pastor...

...Reflexión de nuestro Pastor...

Let yourself be found by God.

The preaching of Jesus from the Gospel of Mark begins with an invitation to repent. "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." Publicans and sinners were the ones moved by this invitation of Jesus. So, they went to Him and listened to the invitation to repent. These publicans and sinners were excluded from the community, raising criticism from the scribes and Pharisees. They were impure and not worthy of God's closeness. Those related to them were also unclean and rejected. That is the case in the Gospel of this Twenty-Fourth Sunday Ordinary Time. With this criticism of the scribes and Pharisees, Jesus presents the aim of his mission. Through the parable of the lost sheep and the lost coin, Jesus teaches us that there is more joy for a lost sheep or coin that is found than one that has never been lost. Jesus lets the scribes and the Pharisees see He has come for those who are lost and alienated from God. He came to show closeness, love, and mercy for those far from Him because of their condition, sinners, publicans, poor people, or sick.

My brothers and sisters, the mission of Jesus is for each one of us. One way or another, we feel like that lost sheep or lost coin. But above all, we want to feel found by Jesus and feel God's closeness, love, and mercy. We want to think that Jesus walks searching for us and feel that Jesus cares about each one of us. Because our condition as humans is fragile, it leaves us lost in sin and lacking faith and hope. But Jesus came precisely for us, to get us and bring us back to the fold, to experience the love, the forgiveness, the mercy of God.

On the other hand, in the second part of the Gospel, with the parable of the Prodigal Son, Jesus shows us the love, mercy, and forgiveness that God offers us because of our repentance. Also, because of letting ourselves be found by Him. That is the condition to feel the love and mercy of God, repentance, going into ourselves, and realizing that we need God. Let's allow Jesus to find us. That happens when we recognize our own mistakes and acknowledge our sins, fail the Father's love and have gotten away from him, and acknowledge that we have failed our neighbor, the husband, the wife, the children, and our parents. At the time of recognition, repentance, and conversion, we are letting ourselves be found by God. Then He comes to us, embraces us, and puts on us new clothes. He puts on us the ring of human dignity and makes a celebration for us because we had been lost and have been found. My brothers and sisters, let's allow God to find us, and let's experience His mercy, love, and forgiveness. This Sunday, we are invited to enter into ourselves, recognize our weaknesses, and, most of all, let God find us and experience His mercy, closeness, forgiveness, and love.

May God bless us all.

Dejémonos encontrar por Dios.

La predicación de Jesús desde el evangelio de Marcos comienza con una invitación al arrepentimiento. "Conviértanse, porque el Reino de los Cielos está cerca". Los publicanos y los pecadores fueron de esos personajes que movidos por esta invitación de Jesús se acercaban a Él, y escucharon la invitación a arrepentirse, lo que ocasionaba las críticas de los escribas y fariseos, ya que para ellos, estos, publicanos y pecadores eran excluidos de la comunidad, eran impuros y no dignos de la cercanía de Dios. Quien se relacionara con ellos, también quedaban impuros o eran rechazados. Este es el caso que nos deja ver el evangelio de este Domingo XXIV del Tiempo Ordinario. Ante esta crítica de los escribas y fariseos, Jesús les responde cual es el objetivo de su misión. A través de la parábola de la oveja y de la moneda perdida, Jesús nos enseña que hay más alegría por la oveja y la moneda encontrada que por las que no se habían perdido. Claramente Jesús les deja ver a los escribas y fariseos que Él ha venido por aquellos que andan perdidos, alejados de Dios, y que El vino a manifestarles la cercanía, el amor y la misericordia de Dios.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, la misión de Jesús es para todos y cada uno de nosotros, de una u otra forma nosotros nos hemos de sentir como esa oveja y esa moneda perdida. Pero sobre todo nos hemos de sentir encontrados por Jesús, y sentir la cercanía, el amor y la misericordia de Dios. Sentir que Jesús anda en nuestra búsqueda, sentir que a Jesús le preocupamos todos y cada uno de nosotros porque nuestra condición como humanos es frágil, débil. Por nuestras condiciones humanas muchas veces nos perdimos, en el pecado, en la falta de fe, en la falta de esperanza. Pero precisamente por nosotros vino Jesús, a buscarnos y hacernos regresar al redil, es decir, regresar a la gracia.

Por otro lado en la segunda parte del evangelio, con la parábola del Hijo Prodigio, Jesús nos muestra el amor, la misericordia y el perdón que Dios nos ofrece, como fruto de nuestro arrepentimiento, como fruto de dejarnos encontrar por El. Esa es la condición para sentir el amor y la misericordia de Dios, arrepentirnos, entrar en nosotros mismos y darnos cuenta de la necesidad de Dios. Nos dejamos encontrar por Jesús, cuando reconocemos nuestro error, cuando reconocemos nuestro pecado, cuando reconocemos que le hemos fallado al Padre, y nos hemos alejado de Él, cuando reconocemos que le hemos fallado al prójimo, al esposo, a la esposa, a los hijos a nuestros padres, en el momento del reconocimiento, del arrepentimiento y de la conversión, nos estamos dejando encontrar por Dios. Entonces El sale a nuestro encuentro, nos abraza, nos reviste de su gracia, nos pone el anillo de la dignidad humana, nos hace una fiesta. Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, dejémonos encontrar por Dios, dejemos que la misericordia, el amor y el perdón de Dios sean nuestro alimento espiritual. Este domingo Él nos está invitando a entrar en nosotros mismos, nos está invitando a sentir el abrazo de Dios, permitámoselo y experimentemos la misericordia de Dios.

Que Dios nos bendiga.


