

The Lazaruses of Our Time

Very often, Jesus invited his disciples to choose between the attachment to wealth and the love of God. That is the central theme of the Gospel of this Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Through the parable of the rich man and poor Lazarus, Jesus invites us to reflect on those who place their hearts on riches and cannot see the needs that many others may have. At the same time, He invites us to be sensitive to the needs of others. The parable is addressed to the Pharisees. We know that, in Jesus' time, the Pharisees were those rich men who exploited the poor and needy. Therefore, Jesus is continually denouncing their behavior.

Jesus invites us to be merciful as the Father is merciful and sensitive to the needs of many of our brothers and sisters. People like Lazarus are begging for human dignity, asking for a piece of bread, looking for a place of shelter, and seeking to solve their legal problems. Like the rich man of the gospel, we often do not want to see them. The world we live in is living this kind of social injustice. The gap between the rich and the poor is getting bigger. We are living the injustice of migration. Many brothers and sisters have been forced to leave their homes because of war, social injustices, the denial of human rights, violence, organized crime, and drug trafficking. People like poor Lazarus are forced to move to other places. Indeed, many countries are opening the doors to these Lazaruses of our time, but many others are not.

The opportunities offered by this country that welcomed us often make us forget where we come from and that once we were also like poor Lazarus, reaching out, hoping that someone would offer us a piece of bread. And although this country offers many possibilities and it seems no one goes hungry, many needy Lazaruses still ask for love, affection, care, and a piece of bread. Many homeless people are looking to be welcome. Our migrant brothers suffer from marginalization, exploitation, and the racism of many people who, like the rich man of the gospel, cannot see the needs of the poor. Many sick brothers and sisters in our parish community live in different homes, feeling lonely and sad, and suffer the weight of the pain of their disease. They are the poor incarnate Lazarus, waiting for a piece of bread, love, affection, care, and attention.

Perhaps in our home and family, our closest neighbors, husband, wife, children, mom, or dad, feel like Lazarus needs affection and caring. How many teenagers and young people are living their youth feeling unloved, like nobody cares for them, and begging for a bit of love? As they do not find it at home, in their families, they refuge in addictions thinking that the addictions will fill their emptiness and help them get ahead. We know that will sink them deeper into poverty and human misery. But today, Jesus invites us not to be blind to so much injustice in our world, environment, and families. Jesus invites us to look around and do something for the Lazaruses who suffer need and hunger. My brothers and sisters, let us be sensitive to the needy and bring the love of God, the love of Jesus, to our brothers and sisters in need. Doing so will manifest that God is with us, present in those Lazaruses we encounter on our way.

May God bless us all.

Los Lazaros de Nuestro Tiempo

Frecuentemente Jesús invita a sus discípulos a escoger entre el apego a las riquezas y el amor de Dios. Este es el tema central del evangelio de este Domingo XXVI del Tiempo Ordinario. A través de la parábola del hombre rico y del pobre Lázaro, Jesús nos invita a reflexionar en esas personas que ponen su corazón en las riquezas y que eso no les permite ver la necesidad que muchos otros tienen. Y por otro lado nos invita a ser sensible a las necesidades de los demás. La parábola va dirigida a los fariseos, ya sabemos que, en tiempos de Jesús, los fariseos eran esos ricos que explotaban a los más pobres y necesitados. Por ello Jesús continuamente les esta denunciación su obrar.

Jesús nos invita a ser misericordiosos como el Padre es misericordioso, siendo sensibles a las necesidades que pasan tantos hermanos nuestros, que como ese pobre Lázaro mendigan por el mundo exigiendo dignidad humana, pidiendo un pedazo de pan, buscando un lugar donde cobijarse, buscando solucionar sus problemas legales, y muchas veces nosotros como el hombre rico no los queremos ver. El mundo que nos ha tocado vivir está viviendo esta injusticia social que nos deja ver el evangelio, cada vez se hace más grande la distancia entre pobres y ricos. Estamos viviendo la injusticia de la migración, muchos hermanos y hermanas se han visto obligados a dejar sus casas por la guerra, por las injusticias sociales, por la explotación de los derechos humanos, por la violencia, por el crimen organizado, por el narcotráfico, y la gente como ese pobre Lázaro se ven obligados a moverse a otros lugares. Muchos países ciertamente les están abriendo las puertas a estos Lazaros de nuestro tiempo, pero mucho otros se las cierran.

Las posibilidades que nos ofrece este país que nos ha acogido, muchas veces hace que se nos olvide de donde provenimos, y nos olvidamos de que alguna vez también nosotros estuvimos como ese pobre Lázaro, extendiendo la mano, deseando que alguien nos ofreciera un pedazo de pan. Y a pesar de que este país ofrece muchas posibilidades y parece que nadie sufre hambre, no es así, sigue habiendo muchos Lazaros necesitados pidiéndonos cariño, afecto, amor, un pedazo de pan, muchos desamparados buscando ser acogidos. Nuestros hermanos migrantes sufren la marginación, la explotación y el racismo de mucha gente que como ese hombre rico del evangelio no son capaces de ver las necesidades de los pobres. Nuestros hermanos y hermanas enfermos, hay muchos en nuestra comunidad parroquial, que están ahí en sus apartamentos sintiéndose solos, tristes, sufriendo el peso del dólar de su enfermedad, ahí está el pobre Lázaro encarnado, esperando un pedazo de pan, de amor, de cariño, de cuidado, de atención.

Tal vez en nuestro mismo hogar y familia, aquel prójimo más cercano a nosotros, como es el esposo, la esposa, los hijos, papa y mama se sientan como ese Lázaro, necesitados de cariño, de una muestra de afecto. Cuantos hijos adolescentes y jóvenes viviendo su etapa humana sienten que nadie los quiere, que no le interesan a nadie, y mendigan un poquito de amor, y como no lo reciben se refugian en las adicciones pensando que eso les llena el vacío y eso les ayudara a salir adelante, pero sabemos que se hunden más en la pobreza y miseria. Pero hoy Jesús nos invita no hacernos ciegos ante tanta injusticia que hay en nuestro mundo, en nuestros ambientes y en nuestras familias. Jesús nos invita a mirar a nuestro alrededor y hacer algo por aquel Lázaro que sufre necesidad y hambre. Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, seamos sensibles y llevemos el amor de Dios, el amor de Jesús a nuestros hermanos que lo necesitan, solo así manifestaremos que Dios está con nosotros, solo así seremos los evangelizadores de nuestro tiempo que buscan de llevar el amor, la misericordia de Dios ahí donde hace falta, especialmente en nuestros hermanos necesitados, en los Lazaros de nuestro tiempo, solo así seremos esa presencia de Dios en medio de nuestro mundo.


