



...A Reflection from our Pastor...

...Reflexión de nuestro Pastor...

Lord, "Increase our faith."

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, speaking of faith, tells us the following. "Faith is a personal act; it is the free response to the initiative of God who reveals himself. But faith is not an isolated act. No one can live the faith alone, just as no one can live alone. No one has faith by himself, as no one has given life to himself. The believer has received faith from others and should hand it over to others. Our love for Jesus and others compels us to speak to others of our faith. Every believer is like a link in the great chain of believers. I cannot believe without being carried by the faith of others, and by my faith, I support the faith of others. For his part, Jesus in the Gospel of this Twenty-Seventh Sunday of Ordinary Time tells us, "If you have faith as a mustard seed, you can say to this tree: 'be uprooted and planted in the sea', and it would obey you."

As the Catechism says, faith is the free human response to God's initiative. God is the one that takes the initiative to go out and meet us. He manifests in our daily lives through our different experiences of Him, the diverse experiences of Jesus, and the various experiences of the Holy Spirit. These experiences we live in each sacrament are an initiative of Jesus Christ offered to us through the sacramental grace. It could be an experience of a spiritual retreat, a time of prayer, a pilgrimage, the solution to some problem, etc. Indeed, God has manifested Himself in different ways to each of us. Maybe we were aware of those experiences. But faith, as the Catechism tells us, is the free human response to this initiative of God, of Jesus and the Spirit out to meet us.

It is through these different experiences of God that faith grows in us. The big problem is that we often do not realize these divine manifestations of God in our lives and, perhaps like the apostles who were with Jesus most of the time, cannot recognize and discover Him as the Son of God. Therefore, we hear them in today's gospel asking Jesus to increase their faith. The multiple experiences they lived with Jesus were His initiative to manifest himself as God and His invitation to be with them. Still, they did not perceive him as God, only as the carpenter's son.

Today's Gospel invites us to be aware of this initiative of God: the moments of Jesus' presence and the actions of the Holy Spirit in our lives. From these experiences, we can respond to God's initiative and increase our desire to be His and our faith. When Jesus told his apostles that if they had faith, they could move mountains, He was not explicitly talking about the mountains in the strict sense of the word. Instead, through faith, we can do great things, like moving mountains of tantrums and anger, removing the mountains of grudges and resentments, the mountains of jealousy and envy, and the mountains of sadness and depression. Those are the kind of mountains that we will be able to remove when we have the grace of God. Only through the experience of Jesus and only under the action of the Holy Spirit will it be possible to increase our faith.

May God bless us all.

Señor, "Auméntanos la fe."

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, hablándonos de la fe nos dice lo siguiente. "La fe es un acto personal, es la respuesta libre del hombre a la iniciativa de Dios que se revela. Pero la fe no es un acto aislado. Nadie puede creer solo, como nadie puede vivir solo. Nadie se ha dado la fe a sí mismo, como nadie se ha dado la vida a sí mismo. El creyente ha recibido la fe de otro, debe transmitirla a otro. Nuestro amor a Jesús y a los hombres nos impulsa a hablar a otros de nuestra fe. Cada creyente es como un eslabón en la gran cadena de los creyentes. Yo no puedo creer sin ser sostenido por la fe de los otros, y por mi fe yo contribuyo a sostener la fe de los otros". Y por su parte Jesucristo en el evangelio de este Domingo XXVII del Tiempo Ordinario, nos dice, "Si ustedes tuvieran fe como un granito de mostaza, le dirían a ese árbol: 'Arráncate de raíz y plántate en el mar'. Y les obedecería".

Como nos dice el catecismo, la fe es la respuesta libre del hombre a la iniciativa de Dios, es decir, es Dios quien ha tomado la iniciativa de salir a nuestro encuentro, de mostrársenos, de manifestarse en nuestras vidas, a través de esas diferentes experiencias de Dios, de Jesucristo y del Espíritu Santo que cada uno de nosotros hemos tenido y vivido. Por ejemplo, la gracia sacramental, cada uno de los sacramentos son una iniciativa de Jesucristo de ofrecerse a nosotros a través de la gracia que nos ofrece cada sacramento. Una experiencia de retiro espiritual, uno momento de oración, una peregrinación, un problema, etc., etc. Sin duda que Dios se ha manifestado en distintas maneras a cada uno de nosotros, tal vez fuimos conscientes de esos momentos, o muchas otras veces tal vez no lo fuimos. Pero la fe, como nos lo dice el catecismo, es la respuesta libre del hombre a esta iniciativa de Dios, de Jesús y del Espíritu de salir a nuestro encuentro.

Es por medio de esas distintas experiencias de Dios, que crece y aumenta nuestra fe. El grave error es que muchas veces no nos damos cuenta de esas manifestaciones divinas en nuestras vidas, y tal vez nos sucede lo que le pasaba a los apóstoles, que estando con Jesús, la mayoría de las veces no fueron capaces de reconocerlo y descubrirlo como el Hijo de Dios, como el Dios con nosotros, y por ello, escuchamos hoy en el evangelio que le piden a Jesús, que les aumente la fe. Las múltiples experiencias que ellos vivieron con Jesús, fueron manifestación e iniciativa de Jesús, de estar con ellos, pero ellos no le percibían como Dios, sino solamente como Jesús el hijo del carpintero.

De este modo el evangelio de hoy nos invita a ser conscientes de esa iniciativa de Dios, de esas presencias de Jesús en nuestras vidas, de esas acciones del Espíritu Santo en nuestro caminar diario, para que desde esas experiencias, respondamos a la iniciativa de Dios y así aumente nuestro deseo de responderle, nuestro deseo de ser de Él, es decir para que aumente nuestra fe. Cuando Jesús les dijo a sus apóstoles que su tuvieran fe podrían mover montañas, no hablaba necesariamente de las montañas en el sentido estricto de la palabra, sino que con fe, se pueden hacer grandes cosas, como tal vez mover las montañas de corajes y enojos, las montañas de rencores y resentimientos, las montañas de celos y envidias, las montañas de tristeza y depresión, esas son las montañas que se mueven solo con la gracia de Dios, solo con la experiencia de Jesús, solo bajo la acción del Espíritu Santo, es decir solo con nuestra experiencia de fe.

Que Dios nos bendiga.


