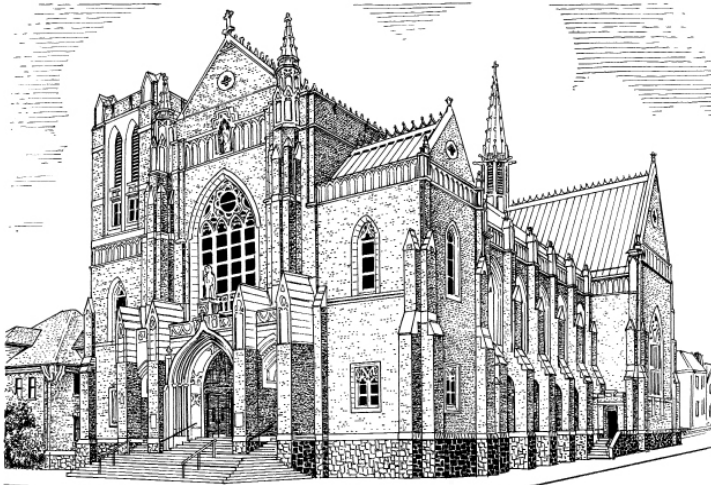

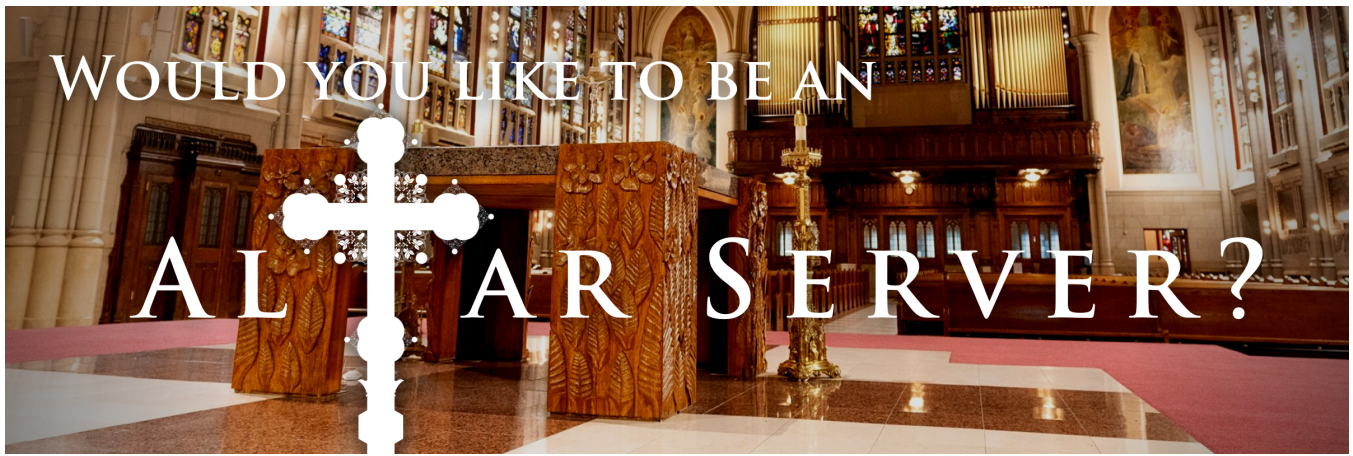

...A Reflection from our Pastor...

...Reflexión de nuestro Pastor...



Rise and go; your faith has made you well.

Leviticus describes the life that the leper had to endure, wandering lonely places, ragged and unkempt, while shouting, "Unclean, unclean!" (Or rather: "I am a sinner!") His home was outside of inhabited places (Lev 13: 45-46). In Jesus' time, leprosy was considered a punishment from God for sins committed. The ban from living among people was upheld with strict rigidity. The healing was comparable to the resurrection of the dead. The healed leper needed confirmation from the priests and the offering of a sacrifice to integrate into the everyday life of society. The Gospel of this Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time lets us see the experience of ten lepers healed by Jesus. It specifically enables us to know the experience of a foreign leper who was aware of Jesus' intervention in his healing and grateful he came back to Jesus to express his gratitude.

The petition of the ten lepers was a cry-made prayer, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" No doubt, these sick individuals suffered not only the pain of the disease but also the consequences of their sickness. Consequences are exclusion from the community and feeling condemned by God for their sin or those of their ancestors. That physical and moral pain leads the ten lepers to kneel before Jesus and beg him to cure their disease and for God's compassion so as not to be convicted for their situation. Indeed that is the cry of thousands of our brothers and sisters and, perhaps, our own cry as we ask for God's compassion. We are invited to reflect on our own leprosy. What are the diseases that make us feel far from God? Maybe we are not sick of leprosy, but perhaps we have let the resentment, anger, envy, and jealousy net inside our hearts, and these diseases do not allow us free. Following the example of those ten sick people of the gospel today, we also must turn to Jesus and ask him to have compassion on us.

Mostly, the gospel of today invites us to experience the healing grace of God. He cures us of our illnesses through the mercy and compassion of Jesus. His death on the cross has already given us healing and salvation. The sacramental grace renews us every day. The encounter with Him through prayer and participation in the life of the Church feeds us. But, as those lepers of the gospel who return thankful to Jesus, we also must recognize Jesus' intervention in our lives and be grateful to Jesus. Unfortunately, often we take the attitude of the other nine cured, and when we are well, healed, have been freed from sin, and our problems are solved, we forget that it was Him. It was Jesus who helped us, healed us, strengthened us, and restored us as God's sons and daughters.

My brothers and sisters, following the example of the healed leper of the gospel, let us go back to Jesus. Let us thank Him for His love, mercy, and compassion. Let's go back and thank Him for what He does for us daily. We should be aware of Jesus' presence. We should be aware of God's intervention in our lives, so let's go and kneel before Him, to hear from his mouth, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."

May God bless us all.

Levántate y vete, tu fe te ha salvado.

El Levítico describe la condición de vida que tenía que soportar el leproso: vagar por lugares solitarios harapiento y despeinado gritando: "¡Impuro, impuro!" (O, mejor dicho: "Soy pecador!") Su morada estaba fuera de lugares habitados (Lev. 13, 45-46). En tiempos de Jesús la lepra era considerada como un castigo de Dios por los pecados cometidos. La prohibición de vivir entre la gente se mantenía con estricta rigidez. La sanación era comparable a la resurrección de un muerto. El leproso que era sanado necesitaba de la confirmación de los sacerdotes y ofrecer un sacrificio, para poder integrarse a la vida normal de la sociedad. El Evangelio de este Domingo XXVIII del Tiempo Ordinario nos deja ver la experiencia de diez leprosos que fueron sanados por Jesús. Pero nos deja ver todavía más, la experiencia de un extranjero que fue consciente de esa intervención de Jesús en su curación, y feliz vuela a Él a expresarle su agradecimiento.

La petición de los diez enfermos de lepra fue un grito hecho oración, "Jesús, maestro, ten compasión de nosotros", sin duda que estos enfermos no solo sufrían el dolor de la enfermedad, sino también las consecuencias de esta, ser excluidos de la comunidad, y hasta sentirse condenados por Dios, por su pecado, o el pecado de sus antepasados. Ese dolor físico y moral es el que los lleva a arrodillarse ante Jesús, y suplicarle no solo la curación de su enfermedad, sino que la compasión de Dios, para no vivir condenados por su situación. Sin duda que ese es el grito de miles y miles de hermanos nuestros, y tal vez el mismo grito de nosotros, pidiendo la compasión de Dios, la compasión de Jesús. Somos invitados a reflexionar cuales son nuestras lepras, cuáles son nuestras enfermedades que nos hacen sentirnos lejos de Dios, tal vemos hemos dejado anidar el resentimiento, el coraje, la envidia, los celos, en el interior del corazón, y esa enfermedad no nos deja ser libres, por ello, como esos diez enfermos del evangelio también nosotros hoy hemos de recurrir a Jesús pidiéndole que tenga compasión de nosotros.

Pero sobre todo el evangelio nos invita a experimentarnos limpios, curados por la misericordia y la compasión de Jesús, su muerte en la cruz nos ha dado ya la curación, la salvación. La gracia sacramental nos renueva día a día. El encuentro con El por la oración y la participación en la vida de la Iglesia nos alimenta. Pero como ese enfermo de lepra que regresó agradecido con Jesús, también nosotros tenemos que darnos cuenta de esa intervención de Jesús en nuestras vidas y conscientes hemos de volver agradecidos con Jesús. Desgraciadamente muchas veces tomamos la actitud de los otros nueve enfermos curados, cuando ya estamos bien, cuando hemos sido curados, cuando hemos sido liberados del pecado, cuando hemos salido del problema, se nos olvida que fue El, Jesús quien nos ayudó, quien nos curó, quien nos fortaleció, quien nos ha restaurado, y nos olvidamos de Él.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, a ejemplo del enfermo curado, volvamos continuamente a Jesús a darle gracias por su amor, a darle gracias por su misericordia, a darle gracias por su compasión, volvamos dándole gracias por cuando día a día hace por nosotros. Tomemos conciencia de esa presencia, de esa intervención de Dios en nuestras vidas, para que así agradecidos nos arrodillemos delante de Él, y podamos escuchar de su boca, "Levántate y vete; tu fe te ha salvado".

Que Dios nos bendiga.
