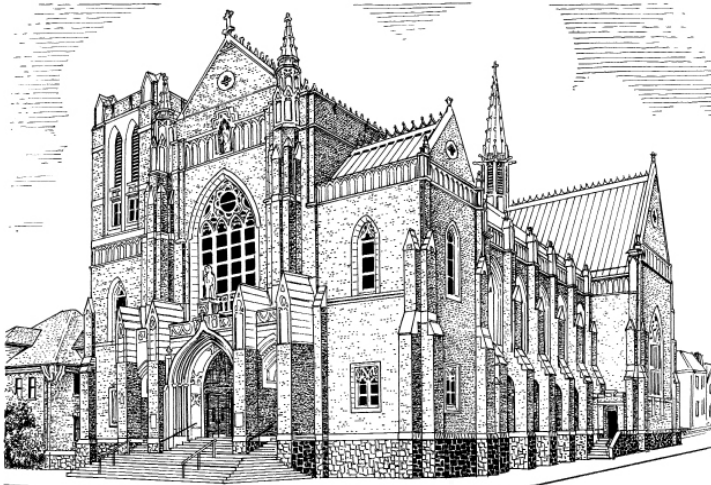

...A Reflection from our Pastor...

...Reflexión de nuestro Pastor...



**“When the Son of Man comes,
will he find faith on earth?”**

Prayer, like working for justice, is a fundamental element that defines our Christianity. The Gospel of this Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time lets us see Jesus’s teaching clearly. Through the parable of the unjust judge and the woman seeking justice, we see the need to pray without getting tired like the woman seeking justice and, from the unjust judge’s position, impart Justice. Above all, through the experience of the woman who asked for justice, not only did she demand justice, but she never ceased to ask for it. In another moment, Jesus is inviting us to be men and women of prayer, inviting us to go into our room and pray and communicate with God. From this woman’s experience in today’s gospel, Jesus invites us not to lose faith or be discouraged when it seems God does not listen to us. God will answer our request at the least expected moment, like the unjust judge that ultimately helped the woman with her request. Jesus clearly tells us these words “then God, would not do justice to his chosen ones who cry to him day and night? I assure you he will avenge them without delay.”

Through the unjust judge who did not fear God, Jesus teaches us that we must be sensitive and aware of the many injustices and needs many people of our time must endure. Our people suffer misunderstandings, suffer humiliation, suffer racism, and discrimination. Often like the unjust judge who did not fear God, we do not want to see those realities, and we do not want to do anything. Jesus calls us as Christians to be men and women of faith. We must work to offer justice and help to the needy. Through the works of mercy, Jesus demands that we be merciful, especially for those who, like that woman in the gospel, suffer social, labor, and even religious injustice. Therefore, as sons and daughters of God, as followers of Jesus, and as Catholics, we must show the merciful face of God. The God that makes the sunshine for everyone – good and evil.

My brothers and sisters, the parable of today's Gospel requires us to be men and women of prayer and invites us not to be discouraged at first. It invites us not to get tired of opening our hearts to God and giving Him glory. We must thank Him and express our needs with complete confidence that he will answer them when we least expect it. It invites us to be men and women of justice and to live our faith showing the merciful face of God. Let God work through us, and as Catholic Christians, show the merciful face of God.

Finally, Jesus invites us to be men and women of faith, that from the experience of God in our lives, we trust Him, and we believe and hope in Him. Jesus questions us, “When the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?” The answer depends on each one of us. With prayer and the experience of justice in our lives, indeed, He will find faith.

May God bless us all.

**“Cuando venga el Hijo del Hombre
¿encontrara fe sobre la tierra?”**

La oración, como el trabajar por la justicia son elementos fundamentales que definen nuestro cristianismo. El evangelio de este Domingo XXIX del Tiempo Ordinario nos deja ver muy claro esta enseñanza de Jesús. A través de la parábola del juez injusto y de la mujer que pedía justicia, nos deja ver, por un lado, con la experiencia de la mujer que pide justicia, la necesidad de orar sin desfallecer, y desde la postura del juez injusto, a impartir justicia. Vemos ante todo la experiencia de la mujer que pedía justicia al juez, no solo pedía justicia, sino que nunca ceso de pedírselo. En otros momentos Jesús nos ha invitado a ser hombres y mujeres de oración invitándonos a entrar en nuestra habitación y ponernos en comunicación con Dios por medio de la oración. Desde la experiencia de esta mujer que pedía justicia Jesús hoy nos invita a no desfallecer, a no desanimarnos cuando parece que Dios no nos escucha, porque en el momento menos esperado Dios responderá a nuestra petición, como ese juez injusto que al final ayudó a la mujer frente a su petición, Jesús nos lo dice muy claro con estas palabras “entonces Dios, ¿no hará justicia a sus elegidos que le gritan día y noche? Yo les aseguro que les hará justicia sin tardar”.

Desde la persona del juez injusto que no temía a Dios, Jesús nos enseña que tenemos que ser sensibles y conscientes de tantas injusticias y necesidades que vive mucha gente de nuestro tiempo. Nuestra gente sufre incomprendiones, humillaciones, racismo y discriminación, y muchas veces como ese juez injusto que no temía a Dios, nosotros no queremos ver esas realidades. Jesús nos pide y nos exige como cristianos que tenemos que ser hombres y mujeres de fe que debemos de trabajar por ofrecer y dar justicia, que debemos ayudar al necesitado. A través de las obras de misericordia Jesús nos exige ser misericordiosos especialmente con aquellos que como esa mujer del evangelio sufren las injusticias sociales, laborales y hasta religiosas. Por ello como hijos e hijas de Dios, como seguidores de Jesús, tenemos que mostrar el rostro misericordioso de Dios, que hace salir el sol para todos, buenos y malos.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, la parábola del evangelio de hoy nos exige ser hombres y mujeres de oración, que no se desaniman a la primera, sino que no se cansan de abrirle el corazón a Dios y darle gloria, darle gracias y también que le piden, que le expresan sus necesidades, con la plena confianza que El responderá en el momento que menos lo esperamos. Nos invita a ser hombres y mujeres de justicia, que vivimos nuestra fe mostrando el rostro misericordioso de Dios. Dejemos obrar a Dios que, a través de nosotros, los cristianos católicos de hoy somos los que hemos de mostrar el rostro misericordioso de Dios.

Por último, Jesús nos invita a ser hombres y mujeres de fe, que, a partir de esa misma experiencia de Dios en nuestras vidas, nos ayudan a confiar, a creer y a esperar en El. Jesús cuestiona si cuando venga el Hijo del Hombre encontrará fe sobre la tierra, la respuesta depende de cada uno de nosotros, si hay oración y vivencia de la justicia en nuestras vidas, seguramente encontrará fe.

Que Dios nos bendiga.
