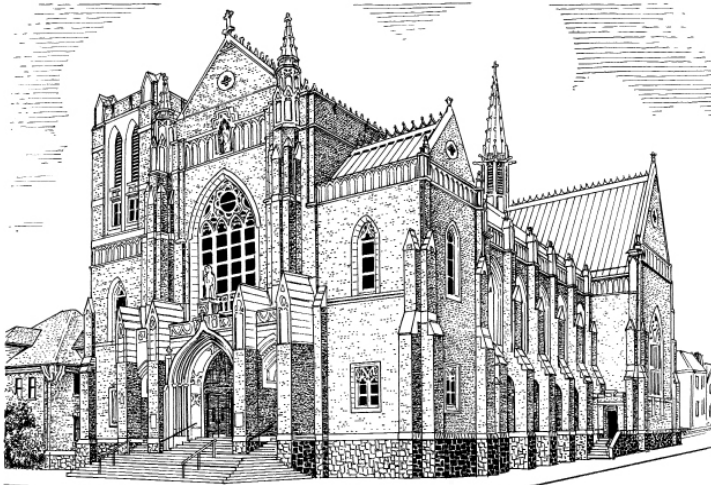

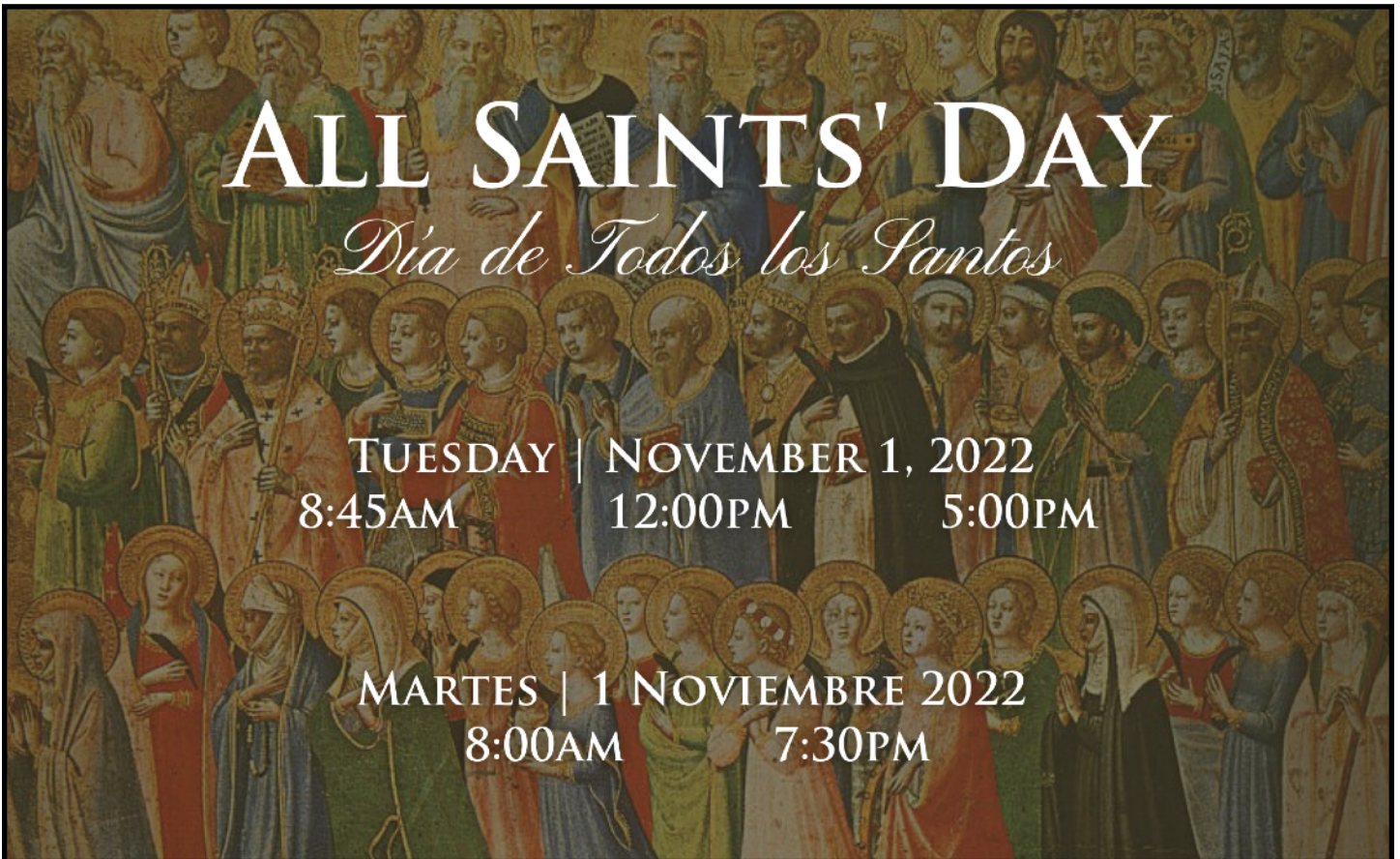

“Oh God, have mercy on me, a sinner!”

Jesus is constantly inviting us to be humble in the Gospel. It is something that must characterize every Christian. Jesus himself was the model of humility. Being God with us, He emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, as St. Paul tells us. Jesus himself at the Last Supper gives us an example of humility by washing the feet of his apostles and inviting us to do the same. That is why in the Gospel of this Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary time, through the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector, Jesus invites us to be humble, saying, “everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.”

The Pharisee in the parable lets us see a negative attitude Jesus denounces. An attitude that God rejects, the attitude of personal pride, selfish pride, and self-contemplation without looking to God. The attitude of looking down on others and considering them less than others. Jesus rejects, detests, and condemns this attitude of the Pharisees. On the other hand, Jesus presents the attitude of the tax collector, an attitude of humility, acknowledgment of his sin, and recognition of the need for God. Through his prayer, we learn a way of looking at God, a humble and straightforward attitude that recognizes the greatness of God and the weakness of human beings.

On October 9, Pope Francis canonized two new saints, Giovanni Battista Scalabrini and Artemide Zatti. No doubt the lives of these brothers and sisters that our Pope now presents to us as models of following Christ. These brothers knew how to live the teachings of today’s Gospel, so they are now exalted, recognized, and revered as saints. Indeed, their prayer was like the publican’s prayer, “O God, have mercy on me, a sinner!” Their shame and humility are now exalted in heaven and on earth proclaimed saints. The call to holiness is not exclusive to some; it is a call for each of us as baptized Catholics. This call is concretized in humility, simplicity, recognizing the greatness of God, acknowledging our sinfulness, and recognizing that only the grace of God can help us grow in the spirit.

My brothers and sisters, the invitation of Jesus in the Gospel of this Sunday is to make the tax collector’s prayer our own prayer and to exclaim like him, “Oh God, have mercy on me, a sinner!” This prayer is an expression of humility, recognizing our own mistakes and sins. It is an example of repentance and recognizing God’s greatness and our trust in Him. No doubt making the tax collector’s words our own and, above all, living those words will allow us to be exalted as those saints presented by Pope Francis this week, one day when the Lord calls us to account for our actions.

My brothers and sisters, let us follow the example of the publican of the Gospel and the saints who we now worship in the Church. Let us pray, “Oh God, have mercy on me, a sinner!”

May God bless us all.

“¡Oh Dios, ten compasión de mí que soy pecador!”

La humildad es una invitación constante de Jesús en el evangelio, es algo que ha de caracterizar a todos y cada uno de los cristianos. Jesús mismo fue el modelo de humildad, El siendo el Dios con nosotros, se anonado así mismo tomando la condición de esclavo, nos dice San Pablo. Y Jesús mismo en la última cena nos da ejemplo de humildad lavando los pies de sus apóstoles y nos invitó a hacer lo mismo. Es por ello por lo que en el evangelio de este domingo XXX del Tiempo Ordinario, Jesús, a través de la parábola del fariseo y el publicano nos invita a ser humildes y nos dice “todo el que se engrandece será humillado, y el que se humilla será engrandecido”.

El fariseo de la parábola nos deja ver una actitud negativa que Jesús denuncia, que Dios rechaza, esa actitud de vanagloria personal, de orgullo egoísta, de mirarse así mismo sin mirar a Dios, la actitud de mirar a los demás por debajo de uno mismo, considerándolos menos, esa actitud del fariseo Jesús la rechaza, la detesta y hasta la condena. Por otro lado, nos presenta la actitud del publicano, una actitud de humildad reconociendo su pecado, reconociéndose necesitado de Dios, con su oración, nos deja ver una forma de mirar a Dios, la actitud humilde y sencilla que reconoce la grandeza de Dios y la humildad humana.

El pasado 9 de Octubre, el Papa Francisco canonizó a dos nuevos santos, Juan Bautista Scalabrini y Artemide Zatti sin duda que la vida de estos hermanos que ahora el Papa nos presentó como modelos de seguimiento de Cristo, son hermanos que supieron vivir las enseñanzas del evangelio de hoy, y por eso son engrandecidos, ensalzados, reconocidos y venerados como santos. Seguramente su oración fue como la del publicano “¡Oh Dios, ten compasión de mí que soy pecador!” Y por su abajamiento, por su humildad ahora son exaltados en el cielo y en la tierra proclamados santos. El llamado a la santidad no es exclusivo de algunos cuantos, sino es un llamado para todos y cada uno de los bautizados llamado que se concretiza en la humildad, en el reconocer la grandeza de Dios, en reconocerse pecador y reconocer que solo la gracia de Dios nos ayuda crecer en el espíritu.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, la invitación de Jesús en el evangelio de este domingo es que también nosotros hagamos de la oración del publicano, nuestra oración, y que también nosotros expresemos “¡Oh Dios, ten compasión de mí que soy pecador!”. Esta oración es expresión de la humildad que Jesús nos exige, expresa el reconocimiento de nuestros errores y pecados, expresa nuestro arrepentimiento, pero sobre todo expresa el reconocimiento de la grandeza de Dios, y nuestra confianza en El. Sin duda que, haciendo nuestras estas palabras del publicano, pero sobre todo viviéndolas, un día, cuando el Señor nos llame a cuentas también nosotros seremos ensalzados, como esos santos que el Papa Francisco nos ha presentado.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, siguiendo el ejemplo del publicano del evangelio y de los santos que ahora veneramos en la Iglesia, oramos “¡Oh Dios, ten compasión de mí que soy pecador!”

Que Dios nos bendiga.


