



Give testimony of Jesus.

The second coming of Jesus Christ is a fundamental element of our Christian Catholic faith. The liturgy of our Catholic Church presents this point of our faith at the end of the liturgical year. On this Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Word of God presents this theme. The gospel story tells us that following the admiration of the temple's beauty, Jesus comments, "As for what you see here, the time will come when not one stone will be left on another; every one of them will be thrown down." At this comment, the people asked Jesus when that would happen and what signs there will be. Jesus did not respond directly to these questions. He did not say when or how this would happen. Faced with the same question, on other occasions, Jesus answered, "Be ready," "Be prepared," because no one knows the day nor the hour. On this occasion, Jesus responds with specific recommendations. "Watch out that you are not deceived. Many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am he, and the time is near.' Do not follow them. When you hear of wars and uprisings, do not be frightened. These things must happen first, but the end will not come immediately."

Our Catholic Church has undergone two great separations: the first was the separation from the Eastern Church in the year 1050. Then there was the Protestant Reformation, initiated primarily by Martin Luther, Henry VIII, and John Calvin between 1517 and 1560. The Eastern Churches, since their beginnings, were different churches. The Eastern Church, from the beginning, was divided into various churches for cultural reasons of language, traditions, and rites. The Protestant Reformation was never born as a single Church. From its beginnings, it has promoted too much division. As a result, we have a significant number of Christian denominations and sects that proliferate in our society. This proliferation of sects has brought the misinterpretation of Jesus Christ's proposal, it is poorly preached, and consequently, we find so many religious groups. These groups deceive people and bring disorientation and confusion to many of our Catholic brothers and sisters in the name of Jesus.

That is why it is crucial to hear the message of Jesus in today's gospel. Many are talking in his name, deceiving people, and causing divisions in the Church, in families, and in society. We are called to listen to Jesus only. He placed in St. Peter and the Apostles the mission of announcing the good news and baptizing in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. He sent them to all nations to proclaim his message of salvation. Jesus shared the message of salvation with the apostles and, through them, with the Catholic Church, represented by their pastors, missionaries, and evangelizers. To avoid deception and confusion from those who usurp the Word of Jesus, we are invited to be prepared, know our faith, and be able to give testimony of it in front of any brother or sister from another Christian denomination who knocks at our door. We do not have to be afraid or ashamed to proclaim the good news. On the contrary, we must give testimony of Jesus.

We know that this work of evangelization is not easy. Jesus himself spoke of persecution, and our Catholic Church has had various moments of persecution and martyrdom from the beginning. Many Catholic brothers and sisters in different parts of the world have been killed for believing and professing their faith in Jesus Christ. That is why Jesus invites us in today's gospel to bear witness to Him, to persevere, and not be afraid to announce the good news of salvation because he who perseveres to the end will be saved.

May God bless us all.

Dar testimonio de Jesús.

La segunda venida de Jesucristo es un elemento fundamental de nuestra fe cristiano-católica. Fue uno de los temas predicados por Jesús. La liturgia de nuestra Iglesia Católica nos presenta, al final del año litúrgico este elemento de nuestra fe. Es por ello por lo que en este XXXIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, la palabra de Dios nos presenta esta temática. Nos dice el evangelio que, ante la admiración de la belleza del templo, Jesús hace un comentario "Esto que ustedes contemplan, llegará un día en que no quedará piedra sobre piedra: todo será destruido", frente a este comentario, le preguntan a Jesús cuando será eso, cuál será la señal. Jesús no respondió directamente a esas preguntas, es decir el no dijo ni cuando, ni cómo. Frente a la misma pregunta, en otras ocasiones Jesús respondió, estén preparados, porque nadie sabe ni el día ni la hora. En esta ocasión Jesús responde con ciertas recomendaciones. "Cuidado con que nadie los engañe. Porque muchos vendrán usurpando mi nombre, diciendo 'Yo soy'".

Nuestra Iglesia Católica, ha sufrido dos grandes separaciones. La primera que se dio entre la Iglesia de Oriente y Occidente en el año 1054 y la segunda, la reforma protestante iniciada ante todo con Martín Lutero, Enrique VIII y Juan Calvino, entre los años 1517 – 1560. La Iglesia Oriental, desde sus inicios fueron distintas iglesias, ya que, desde su separación, esa Iglesia estaba ya dividida por razones culturales, de lengua, tradiciones y ritos. La reforma protestante, nunca nació como una sola Iglesia, desde sus inicios ha promovido demasiado la división, resultado de ello tenemos la gran cantidad de denominaciones cristianas y sectas que proliferan en nuestra sociedad. Esta proliferación de sectas ha traído consigo que la propuesta de Jesucristo se mal interprete, se mal predique y como consecuencia nos encontramos tantos y tantos grupos religiosos, tantas y tantas personas que en el nombre de Jesús engañan a la gente, la desorientan dejando confundidos a muchos de nuestros hermanos y hermanas católicos.

Por ello es muy importante escuchar el mensaje de Jesús hoy, muchos andan usurpando su nombre, engañando a la gente y ocasionando divisiones en la Iglesia, en las familias y en la sociedad. Hemos de escuchar solamente a Jesús, quien depositó en San Pedro y los Apóstoles la misión de anunciar la buena noticia, de bautizar en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo, a quienes envió a todas las naciones a proclamar su mensaje de salvación. Ese mensaje de salvación fue depositado en los apóstoles y a través de ellos a la Iglesia Católica, representada por sus pastores, misioneros y evangelizadores. Para no ser engañados y confundidos por esos que usurpan la palabra de Jesús, somos invitados a estar preparados, a conocer nuestra fe, para así poder dar testimonio de ella, frente a cualquier hermano o hermana separado que toca a nuestra puerta, no debemos tener miedo, o vergüenza de proclamar la buena noticia, por el contrario, hemos de dar testimonio de Jesús.

Sabemos que este trabajo evangelizador no es fácil, Jesús mismo nos habló de persecuciones, y nuestra Iglesia Católica desde sus inicios ha tenido diversos momentos de persecución y de martirio, muchos de nuestros hermanos y hermanas católicos en diversas partes del mundo han sido asesinados, por el simple hecho de creer y profesar su fe en Cristo Jesús. Por ello Jesús nos invita en el evangelio de hoy, a dar testimonio de Él, a perseverar, a no tener miedo de anunciar esa buena noticia de salvación, porque el que persevera hasta el final, se salva.


