



“This is the King of the Jews.”

With this Thirty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we reach the end of the liturgical year. After having been reflecting and living the mysteries of Jesus' life, we proclaim Him as our King. Also, we know that the reign of Jesus is not built on human approaches like power, prestige, properties, etc. The reign of Jesus is spiritual, a divine reign. Pilate ordered to put the inscription upon the cross, "This is the King of the Jews," in a mocking and offensive way. Yet, he told the truth. Jesus is not only the King of the Jews but all humanity, of all who recognize him as a savior, Lord, and King.

The word of God on this Sunday lets us see that final moment of the life of Jesus among us, the moment of the cross. But that moment, although humanly speaking was painful, was also glorious because Jesus was proclaimed King. First, the same Pilate, without knowing who Jesus was, ordered to fix the inscription "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews" on the cross. The good thief also proclaims him as such. He recognized him as king when he asked Jesus to accept him in his kingdom. Perhaps he was not aware of what he was saying. However, asking Jesus to admit him into his kingdom. Jesus' response to the good thief, "I assure you, today you will be with me in paradise," is talking about his kingdom.

Through this inscription on the cross of Jesus, the request of the good thief, but also because Jesus himself recognized before Pilate when he answered, "You have said it, I am king", all of us, followers of Jesus, also proclaim Him as our King, and the entire Universal Catholic Church, today recognize Him as our King of the Universe. But this proclamation and celebration of Jesus as King demands from us a commitment to live as subjects of our King, following His word, living the beatitudes, living the commandment of love, forgiveness, and service. We recognize Him as our King and Lord with our actions and attitudes.

If Jesus is not yet the Lord of all our existence, today is the time we can proclaim Him as such. This is the moment to do it. This is the time to make up our minds and sell all the pearls to be able to buy the precious one. This is the time to make up our minds to surrender everything to stay with Jesus. It really is worth it. Precisely, the Lordship of Jesus consists in doing everything He wants and only what He wants, as He wants and when He wants it. How will Jesus tell us what His will is? In every circumstance we find ourselves, it is enough to ask ourselves how Jesus would act if He were in my place. You must ask Jesus himself: Would you buy this dress, Lord Jesus? How would you use this money, Lord Jesus? How would you, Jesus, love your brothers, friends, and enemies? Do it just as Jesus would. "Do whatever he tells you," said the Woman who was truly "the slave of the Lord" and in whom the Word of God became flesh.

My brothers and sisters, let us proclaim our faith in Jesus, proclaim Him our King, and live what He asks us to live in his kingdom, love, justice, peace, forgiveness, respect, solidarity, help, and service. These are the indispensable conditions to belong to Jesus' kingdom.

May God bless us all.

“Este es el Rey de los Judíos”.

Con este XXXIV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, llegamos al final del año litúrgico. Y después de haber estado reflexionando y viviendo los misterios de la vida de Jesús, lo proclamamos nuestro Rey. Sabemos nosotros que el reinado de Jesús no es un reinado al estilo y desde los planteamientos humanos, es decir, poder, prestigio, propiedades etc. El reinado de Jesús es un reinado espiritual, un reinado divino. Pilato mandó poner aquella inscripción, "Este es el Rey de los Judíos", de una manera burlesca y hasta ofensiva, sin embargo, decía la verdad, Jesús es no solo el Rey de los Judíos, sino de toda la humanidad, de todo aquel que lo reconoce como Rey.

La palabra de Dios de este domingo nos deja ver ese momento final de la vida de Jesús entre nosotros, el momento de la cruz. Ese momento, aunque humanamente hablando es doloroso, es también un momento glorioso, porque Jesús está siendo proclamado Rey, ante todo por parte del mismo Pilato, que sin saber quién era Jesús, mando poner esa inscripción "Jesús Nazareno, Rey de los Judíos" en la cruz. Pero también el buen ladrón lo proclama como tal, al pedirle a Jesús lo acepte en su reino, lo está reconociendo como su Rey, tal vez tampoco era consciente de lo que decía, sin embargo, pidiéndole a Jesús lo admitiera en su reino, lo proclama su Rey. La respuesta de Jesús al buen ladrón es una respuesta de Rey, "Te lo aseguro, hoy estarás conmigo en el paraíso", es decir en su reino.

Por esa inscripción en la cruz de Jesús, por la petición del buen ladrón, pero también porque Jesús mismo lo reconoció ante Pilato cuando este le preguntó si Él era rey, y Jesús respondió, "tú lo has dicho, yo soy rey" todos nosotros, sus seguidores también lo proclamamos nuestro Rey, y toda la Iglesia Católica Universal, hoy lo reconocemos como nuestro Rey del Universo. Pero esta proclamación y celebración de Jesús como Rey, nos exige un compromiso, nos exige vivir como súbditos de nuestro Rey, cumpliendo su palabra, viviendo las bienaventuranzas, viviendo el mandato del amor, del perdón, del servicio, solo con nuestras acciones y actitudes, es que lo reconocemos como nuestro Rey y Señor.

Si Jesús no es todavía realmente el Señor de toda tu existencia, hoy es el momento en que lo puedes proclamar como tal. Este es el lugar y momento para hacerlo. Decídate a vender todas las perlas para poder comprar la Perla preciosa. Decídate a entregarlo todo para quedarte con Jesús. En verdad vale la pena. Concretamente el Señorío de Jesús consiste en que hagamos todo y sólo lo que Él quiere, como Él quiere y cuando Él quiere. ¿Pero, cómo nos dirá Jesús cuál es su voluntad? Muy sencillo. En cada circunstancia en que nos encontremos bastara con preguntarnos ¿cómo actuaría Jesús si estuviera en mi lugar? Es más, hay que preguntarle al mismo Jesús: ¿Compraría este vestido, Señor Jesús? ¿Cómo usarías tú el dinero, Señor Jesús? ¿Cómo amarías, Jesús, a tus hermanos, amigos y enemigos?... y hacerlo tal como lo haría Jesús. "Hagan lo que él les diga", nos dijo la Mujer que realmente fue "esclava del Señor" y en quien la Palabra de Dios se hizo carne.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, profesemos nuestra fe en Jesús, proclamémoslo nuestro Rey y vivámoslo lo que nos pide para vivir en su reino de amor, de justicia, de paz, de perdón, de respeto, de solidaridad, de ayuda, de servicio y entrega, vayamos al evangelio, está lleno de las exigencias de Jesús, que son las condiciones indispensables para ser de su reino.

Que Dios nos bendiga.
