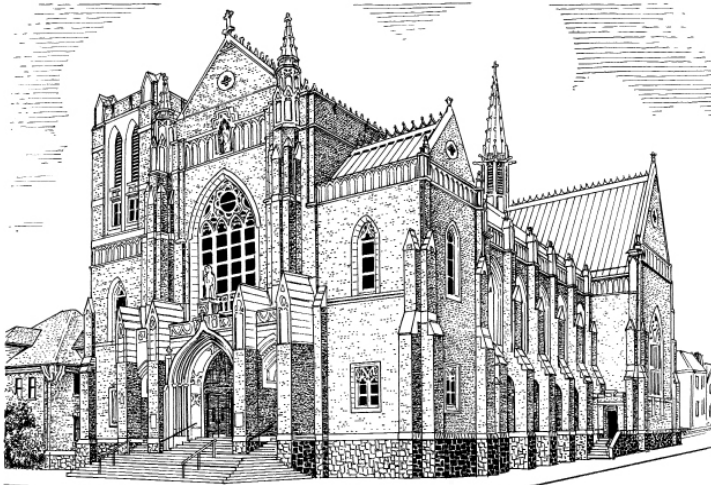

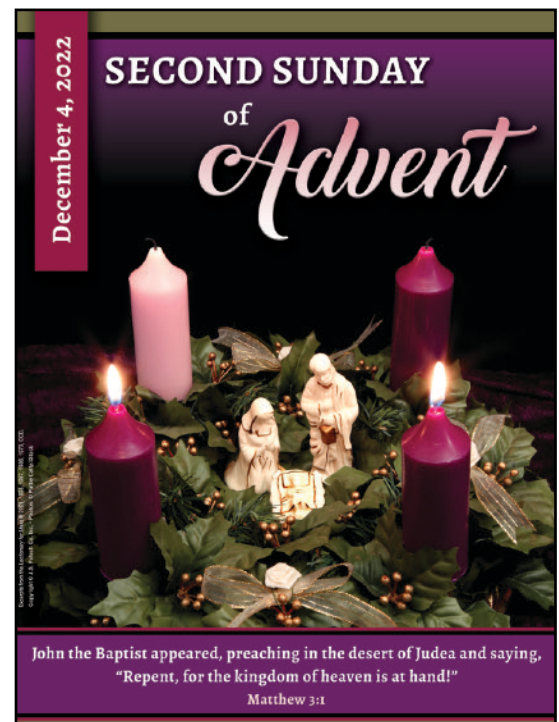



Prepare the way of the Lord.

Last week, we heard Jesus inviting us to be alert. On this second Sunday of Advent, we hear John the Baptist inviting us to prepare the way for the Lord who comes, the Savior who is near, and the expected Messiah. John the Baptist is a crucial character in this season of Advent. Considered the last of the prophets of the Old Testament, he invites us to prepare the way for Jesus coming behind him.

Certainly, the cry of John is an invitation at this present moment to evaluate our life of faith. This time of Advent invites us to prepare for the birth of Jesus. We are invited to remember Jesus in his historical incarnation. It is also a reminder that Jesus wants to be born again. He wants to be flesh of our flesh, but we must be prepared. Advent invites us to look to Jesus' birth and his incarnation and remember that event, but Jesus wants to be born again, incarnated in a pure heart, in a happy family, in a renewed Church. For that, each of us must reflect has to be prepared.

That preparation is an invitation to see our lives and daily walking, how we are in our relationship with others, especially with our family, our loved ones, and our coworkers. How are we doing in our life of faith, in our experience of Church? How are we doing in our relationship with God? This reflection helps us to prepare for the birth of Jesus. It is like when we start to set the Christmas tree, the crib figures, the lights that adorn our homes beautifully and, before we put them in place, we clean them so they look more beautiful. So, we must remove and clean all that disfigures our hearts, disfigures our human beings and our families, and clean negative memories, grudges, anger, resentments, everything that prevents Jesus' incarnation and doesn't allow him to be born in us.

This preparation for the birth of Jesus offers us salvation as John tells us, "All flesh shall see the salvation of God." Salvation means loving Jesus' message, peace, justice, love, and truth. In his incarnation, death, and resurrection, Jesus has saved us and freed us. But we must work to live this liberation, to live that salvation, through the experience of Jesus' message.

My brothers and sisters, let us allow Jesus to be born; let us allow Jesus to be incarnated, preparing the way, paving the trails, straightening the crooked, in our life, in our families, and our church.

May God bless us all.

Preparen el camino del Señor.

La semana pasada, escuchamos a Jesús que nos invitaba a estar alertas. En este segundo domingo de adviento escuchamos a Juan el Bautista que vienen invitándonos a preparar el camino al Señor que viene, al Salvador que se acerca, al Mesías esperado. Juan el Bautista es un personaje fundamental en este tiempo de Adviento, considerado el último de los profetas del Antiguo Testamento, invito al pueblo a prepararle el camino a Jesús que venía detrás de él.

Sin duda el grito de Juan es una invitación en este momento presente a evaluar nuestra vida de fe. Este tiempo de Adviento nos invita a prepararnos a ese nacimiento de Jesús, nacimiento que, si es verdad que recordamos haciendo memoria de ese acontecimiento histórico, también es una invitación actual, Jesús nuevamente quiere nacer, quiere hacerse carne, en nuestra carne, pero para ello hemos de estar preparados. El Adviento nos invita a mirar al nacimiento de Jesús, a su encarnación, pero Él quiere encarnarse en un corazón puro, en un corazón limpio, en una familia feliz, en una Iglesia renovada, y para ello cada uno de nosotros tiene que reflexionar, hay que prepararse, ¿qué hay que hacer para que Jesús se encarne, nazca, se haga vida en nuestra vida?

Esa preparación nos invita a ver nuestra vida, a ver nuestro caminar de cada día, ¿Cómo estamos en las relaciones interpersonales?, sobre todo con nuestra familia, con nuestros seres queridos, con nuestros compañeros de trabajo. ¿Cómo estamos en nuestra vida de fe, en nuestra vivencia de Iglesia? ¿Cómo estamos en nuestra relación con Dios? Esta reflexión nos ayuda a prepararle el nacimiento a Jesús. Y así como hemos comenzado a sacar el árbol de navidad, las figuras del pesebre, la serie de luces que adornan hermosamente nuestras casas, y antes de colocarlas, las limpiamos para que luzcan más hermosas, así hemos de sacar y limpiar todo aquello que afea nuestro corazón, y limpiarlo, los recuerdos negativos, los rencores, los enojos, los corajes, los resentimientos, todo aquello que le impide a Jesús encarnarse, que le impide nacer.

Esta preparación al nacimiento de Jesús nos ofrece la salvación, como nos dice Juan, "todos verán la salvación de Dios", salvación que no es otra cosa que hacer vida el mensaje de Jesús, mensaje de Paz, Justicia, amor, verdad. La salvación, mis hermanos y mis hermanas no la hemos de esperar solo al final de los tiempos, la tenemos que hacer presente aquí y ahora. En su encarnación, muerte y resurrección Jesús ya nos ha salvado, nos ha liberado, pero nosotros tenemos que hacer presente esa liberación, esa salvación, en la vivencia del mensaje de Jesús.

Mis hermanas y mis hermanos, dejemos a Jesús nacer, dejemos a Jesús encarnarse, dejémoslo hacerse hombre, hacerse mujer, hacerse vida, preparándole el camino, allanando los senderos, enderezando lo torcido, solo así Jesús nacerá en nuestras vidas, en nuestras familias, en nuestro mundo y en Iglesia.

Que Dios nos bendiga.




Come See the Kids Play!
