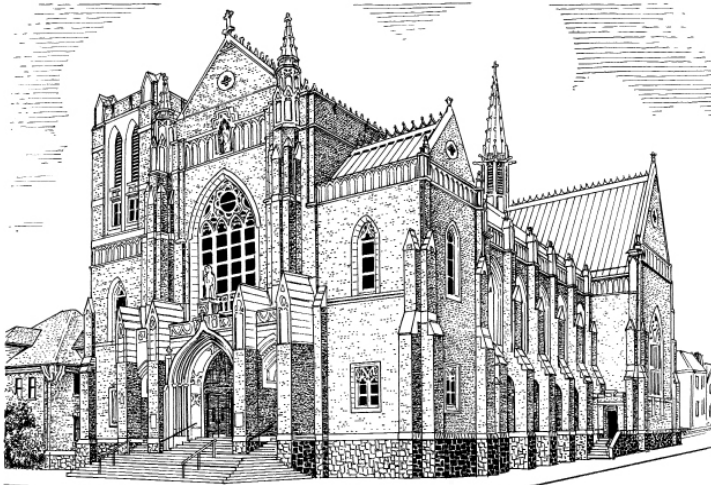

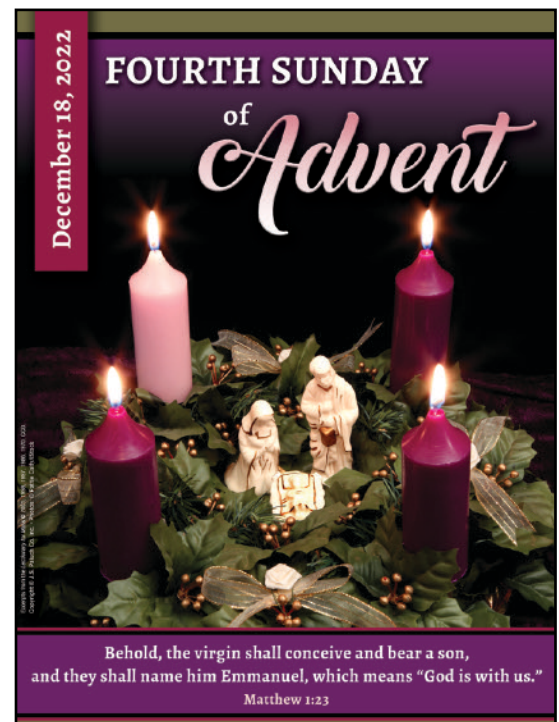



Being a witness of Jesus

With this Sunday, we are already in the Fourth and last Week of the Advent season. The event of the birth of Jesus is nearby. Re-examining the previous weeks, during the first week, Jesus invited us to be alert. In the second week, John asked us to repent, convert, and prepare the way for the Lord. In the third week, Jesus came inviting us to give testimony, communicate and announce all that he did and spoke. This fourth week is the week of the Announcement. The announcement of the Angel Gabriel to Mary and Joseph, who God has chosen to collaborate in the divine plan of salvation, is why the Gospel of this Fourth Sunday of Advent tells us how the birth of Jesus occurred. And with it, we are also invited to announce God's plan, which is the Incarnation and the birth of Jesus in our lives.

There is no doubt that the Angel Gabriel also announces that the word becomes flesh, that God lowered himself and is made like one of us. His name is Emmanuel; God is with us, and we should not be afraid to say YES to God, like Mary and Joseph. And He invites us to announce this great mystery. My brothers and sisters, this fourth week of Advent, the liturgy invites us to announce that the Lord is near and that the real Christmas is not the purchases, the parties, or the dinners. But the true Christmas is to say YES to God. Yes, to love, yes to peace, yes to justice, yes to dialogue, yes to faith, yes to prayer, yes to service. Only from the experiences of these human-Christian values, we will be living a real Christmas.

The gospel invites us to "Learn from Mary and accept Christ the Light of the World." We are invited to learn from Joseph and not be afraid to say yes to God's plan. As a family, we must live the harmony and joy that this celebration represents. All preparations should center on accepting Jesus in our hearts, families, and communities. In families, promoting respect and dialogue, help and support for each other, between husbands and between parents and children. We are living in forgiveness if there are misunderstandings and offenses. As a family, we are required to be witnesses as parents to our children, before all, witnesses of faith, testimonies of love, pardon, and forgiveness, testimonies of communication and communion, being testimonies of dialogue among the family.

Christmas also requires us to announce to our brothers and sisters in faith the joy of the birth of Jesus through service and apostolate. Through the experience of faith in the different ministries, our parish offers us spaces of learning, service, and prayer. If our work gives us freedom, we can offer something of our time to our church by putting the gifts received to the benefit of others. Every gift received is to be provided at the service of the community. This fourth week of Advent not only invites us to announce the birth of Jesus in our families and parish community but also sends us to announce it in our society, in our present world. Today in society, there is a need for God, of Jesus, and to live the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Christmas sends us to announce the birth of Jesus with our life. May the YES of Mary and Joseph encourage us also to say YES, and may YES enable us to be the good news messengers wherever the Lord sends us.

May God bless us all.

En la segunda semana Juan nos invitó al arrepentimiento y a la conversión, y a prepararle el camino al Señor. La tercera semana Jesús vino invitándonos a dar testimonio y comunicar y anunciar todo lo que El hace y dice. Esta cuarta semana es la semana del Anuncio, el anuncio del Ángel Gabriel a María y a José que han sido escogidos por Dios para colaborar en el plan divino de la salvación. Por eso el evangelio de este Cuarto Domingo de Adviento nos narra el nacimiento de Jesús, pero resalta el anuncio del Ángel a María y a José. Y con ello también nosotros somos invitados a anunciar el plan de Dios, que es la Encarnación y el nacimiento de Jesús en nuestras vidas.

No hay duda de que también a nosotros el Ángel Gabriel nos anuncia que la palabra se hace carne, que Dios se abaja y se hace como uno de nosotros, que su nombre es el Emmanuel, es decir, Dios con nosotros, que no tengamos miedo de decirle SI a Dios, como María y como José. Y nos invita a anunciar ese gran misterio. Mis hermanas y mis hermanos esta cuarta semana de Adviento la liturgia nos invita a anunciar que el Señor está cerca, que la verdadera navidad no son las compras, ni las fiestas, ni las cenas, sino que la verdadera Navidad es decirle SI a Dios, si al amor, si a la paz, si a la justicia, si al diálogo, si a la fe, si a la oración, si el servicio y a la entrega generosa, solo desde la vivencia de estos valores humano-cristianos estaremos viviendo la verdadera Navidad.

El evangelio de hoy nos invita a "Aprender de María y aceptar a Cristo que es la Luz del Mundo". Aprender de José y no tener miedo de decirle Si al plan de Dios. Como familia debemos vivir la armonía y la alegría que esta celebración representa. Todos los preparativos se deben centrar en aceptar a Jesús en los corazones, las familias y las comunidades. En las familias promoviendo el respeto y el dialogo, la ayuda y el apoyo entre esposos y entre padres e hijos, viviendo el perdón si hay malentendidos, siendo pacientes si hay dificultades. Como familia nos exige ser testimonios como padres hacia nuestros hijos, ante todo testimonio de fe, ser testimonios de amor, ser testimonios de comunicación, dialogando con ellos de su vida y sus problemas.

La Navidad también nos exige anunciar a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en la fe la alegría del nacimiento de Jesús, a través del servicio y apostolado, a través de la vivencia de la fe en los diferentes ministerios que nuestra parroquia nos ofrece, como espacios de aprendizaje, de servicio, de oración, de anuncio. Si nuestro trabajo nos deja espacio, podemos ofrecer algo de nuestro tiempo poniendo al servicio de los demás los dones recibidos, todo don recibido es para ponerlo al servicio de la comunidad. Esta cuarta semana de adviento no solo nos invita anunciar el nacimiento de Jesús en nuestras familias, en nuestra comunidad parroquial, también nos envía a anunciarlo en la sociedad. En nuestro mundo y sociedad hay mucha necesidad de Dios, hay mucha necesidad de Jesús, hay mucha necesidad de la vivencia de los dones del Espíritu Santo. Pues Navidad nos envía a anunciar el nacimiento de Jesús con nuestra vida. Que el SI de María y de José, nos animen a nosotros a decir también que SI, y que ese Si nos anime a ser mensajeros de buenas noticias ahí donde el Señor nos envía.

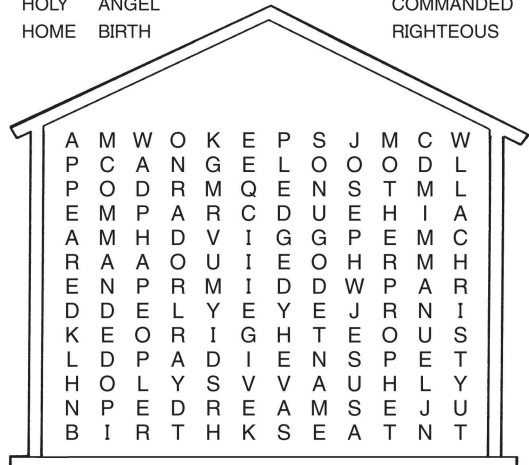
