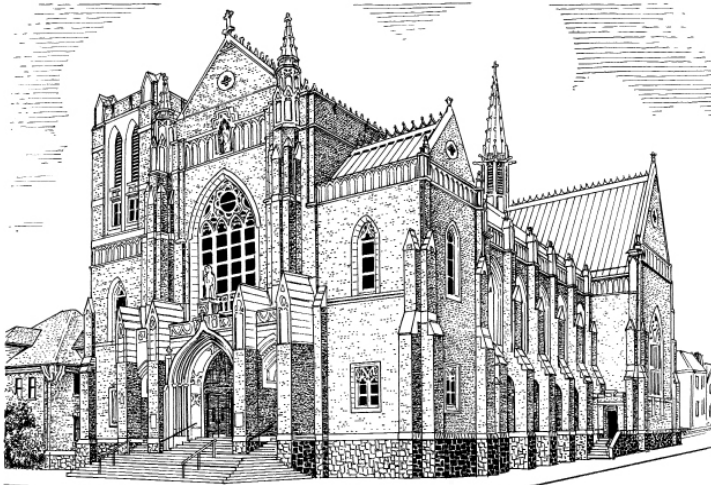



Today, the Savior has been born.

“Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the city of David, a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord”. This was the Angel’s announcement to the shepherds and is the Announcement of the Church to all humanity, Christians, and Catholics of the world. The Savior is born; therefore, we do not have to be afraid. My brothers and sisters, it’s Christmas. That is, Jesus is made flesh again. Jesus is born again, not in Bethlehem, but in our hearts, in our human being, in our lives, and in our families. And that is why today, the whole Catholic Church rejoices.

The media show us so many misfortunes in our world, wars, violence, organized crime, disintegrated families, personal problems, illnesses, disappointments, discouragements, and so many things that may border on fear. But today, Jesus, too, invites us not to be afraid. Jesus, the Messiah, the Savior of the world, the one born in Bethlehem, is born to us today, and only He can help us get ahead in all that we are burdened. Like those shepherds who listened to the Angel and went to meet and worship Him in the manger, we are also called to go and meet Him in our life, our history, our hearts, and the hearts of our families.

Christmas is not the memory of what happened years ago. The real Christmas is to allow Jesus to incarnate again, to be born again, and to become one of us. This is the true Christmas, to say YES to Jesus. This Christmas invites us to say yes to life, to our being sons and daughters of God, to our being followers and followers of Jesus, and to being sons and daughters of the Catholic Church. That is why today, with the whole Church, we rejoice and commit ourselves to announce that Jesus is born. Indeed, recognizing Jesus as the Son of God commits us to be His very presence in the world through peace and justice, in love and forgiveness, in service and help to the needy, in sharing what we are and what we have, that is, in embodying the gospel. Only in this way do we genuinely manifest that Jesus is born to us.

My brothers and sisters, let us listen to the Angel’s announcement. Let us go to our Bethlehem, to our manger, that is to say, let’s go to our heart, go to the heart of our family, go to our apostolate group, and go to our Church. To live the birth of Jesus is an invitation to live the gospel. Only thus will we experience salvation; we will share the joy that brings us the incarnation and the birth of Jesus. The Nativity invites us to do an act of faith, believe in Him, hope in Him, and experience Him alone. My brothers and sisters, it is Christmas, and Jesus has been born to us. Let’s unite with the angels and sing, “Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth, peace to those on whom his favor rests.”

Secret Carol

The carol, "The Twelve Days of Christmas" was written for Catholic children during the three centuries of Catholic suppression in England. Besides the surface meaning, the hidden meaning taught a simple catechesis.

The partridge in the pear tree is Jesus Christ. The two turtle doves were the Old and New Testament. The three French hens were faith, hope and charity. The four calling birds were the four Gospels. The five golden rings represent the Pentateuch.

Six geese for six days of creation; seven swans, the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit; eight maids, the eight Beatitudes; nine ladies, the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit; ten lords, ten Commandments; eleven pipers for the faithful apostles and the twelve drummers the twelve points of belief in the Apostles Creed.

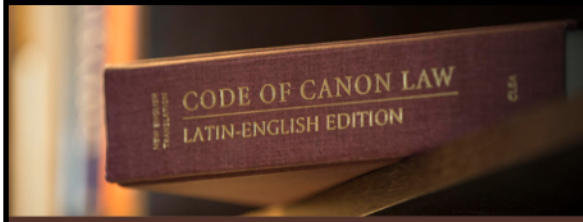
